The band were originally signed to Island Records, but swapped over to Polydor in 1977, so all albums below which say "released 1977" were originally released on Island. Catalogue numbers are Polydor numbers.

So albums first: 'Roxy Music' (2302048), released January 1977; 'For Your Pleasure' (2302049), released January 1977; 'Stranded' (2302050), released January 1977; 'Country Life' (2302051), released January 1977; 'Siren' (2302052), released January 1977; 'Viva! Roxy Music' (2302053), released January 1977; 'Roxy Music's greatest Hits' (2302073), released November 1977 (first to be released on Polydor only); 'Manifesto' (POLH1), released March 1979; 'Flesh And Blood' (POLH2), released May 1980.
