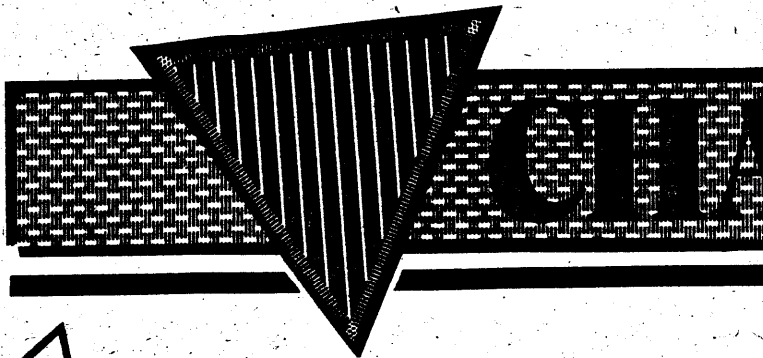

Tracks on Jailhouse Rock EP: Jailhouse Rock/Young And Beautiful/I Want To Be Free/Don't Leave Me Now/Baby I Don't Care. On Strictly Elvis EP: Old Shep/Any Place Is Paradise/Paralysed/It's So Strange. On Follow That Dream EP: Follow that Dream/Angel/What A Wonderful Life/I'm Not The Marrying Kind. On 5 July 62 a note on the Top 50 for that week started "Due to difficulties in assessing returns of Follow That Dream EP, it has been decided not to include it in Britain's Top 50. It is of course No. 1 in the EP charts". Therefore this EP only had a 2 week run on the chart when it sales would certainly have justified a much longer one: Beyond The Reef listed only 30 Aug to 13 Sep 60.
