THIS WEEK'S CHART

● ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

● **Kylie Minogue's** 'I Should Be So Lucky' is Britain's number one single for the fifth week in a row this week, a fact due more to a woeful lack of strong opposition than any great musical merit of its own. In fact, 'I Should Be So Lucky' sold fewer copies last week (around 48,000) than any other number one in the last five years.

'I Should Be So Lucky' is also number one in Ireland and Australia, Kylie's home country. In Britain, it ties with **Jennifer Rush's** 'The Power Of Love' as the longest running number one by a female soloist since **Freda Payne's** six week topper 'Band Of Gold' in 1970.

If Kylie can hang on for another week, she'll equal the record number of weeks at number one by an Aussie, set by **Rolf Harris** and 'Two Little Boys' in 1969 — but the odds are stacked heavily against her. Since 'Two Tribes' reigned for nine weeks in 1984, half a dozen other records have topped for five weeks, but none has managed to make it six weeks. In addition to 'The Power Of Love', there's **Stevie Wonder's** 'I Just Called To Say I Love You', **Band Aid's** 'Do They Know It's Christmas', **Paul Hardcastle's** '19', **Rick Astley's** 'Never Gonna Give You Up' and **T'Pau's** 'China In Your Hand'. If Kylie isn't going to be number one, who is? Rick Astley and **Vanessa Paradis's** sales are diminishing rapidly, so the smart money is on **Aswad's** 'Don't Turn Around', which bounds from number 22 to number four. The group's track record — they've never before had a top 50 hit — hardly inspires confidence, but 'Don't Turn Around' was written by Dianne Warren and Albert Hammond, whose last alliance produced the number one hit 'Nothing's Gonna Stop Us Now' for **Starship**. The original recording of 'Don't Turn Around', incidentally, appears on the flipside of **Tina Turner's** 1986 single 'Typical Male'.



● **TERENCE still the tops**

Warren could equal Stock, Aitken and Waterman's feat of having simultaneous number ones in Britain and America with different songs: 'I Get Weak', which she wrote for **Belinda Carlisle**, is number two in the States this week, and seems likely to depose Rick Astley's 'Never Gonna Give You Up'.

● 'Only In My Dreams' by **Debbie Gibson** returns to the chart this week at number 37, five months after it peaked at number 54. A much better song than Gibson's recent number seven hit 'Shake Your Love', it seems likely to be a bigger hit, possibly even a number one.

● After a fierce battle with 'The Best Of OMD', which nudged slightly ahead during the week, **Terence Trent D'Arby's** 'Introducing The Hardline According To...' fought back, and just managed to retain its leadership of the album chart for the eighth week in a row, and ninth in total. Next week, both albums seem likely to be overtaken by **Morrissey's** 'Viva Hate', which is even now selling like the proverbial hotcakes. So, let's bid farewell, however briefly, to 'The Hardline' with a few pertinent facts:

★ 'Introducing The Hardline' has spent

more consecutive weeks at number one (eight) than any album since **Dire Straits'** 'Brothers In Arms' topped for 10 weeks in a row at the beginning of 1986.

★ It's the longest running number one by an American artist since the **Kids From Fame's** self-titled album ruled the roost for 12 weeks in 1982.

★ Thus far, 'Introducing The Hardline' has sold 1,400,000 copies in the UK, and yielded four hit singles. Its success justified CBS' confidence in D'Arby — a confidence that led them unusually, to release to the media a special promotional cassette entitled 'Work In Progress' more than a year ago, long before 'The Hardline' was released. It included four tracks, amongst them early, incomplete versions of 'If You Let Me Stay' and 'Wishing Well', the latter of which this week becomes D'Arby's first US top 20 hit.

● **Alexander O'Neal's** 'Hearsay', currently the subject of TV promotion, responds by jumping 12 notches to number six in the album chart this week. That's the highest position it's achieved in a 33 week chart residency.

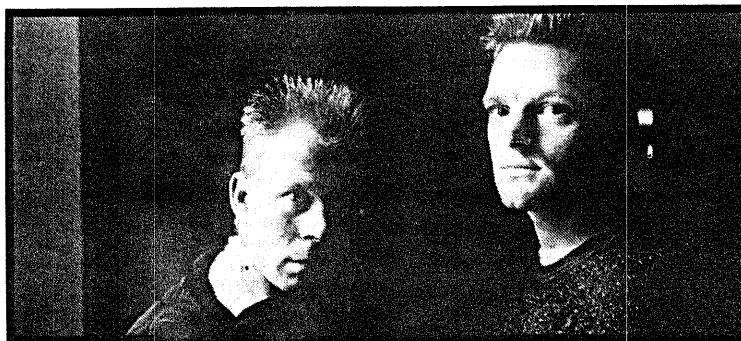
● **Heart's** 'Never/These Dreams' sprints six places this week to become the eleventh title to top the CD Singles chart in as many weeks. This week's top 20, with last week's positions in brackets:

● **ERRATA:** In last week's Chartfile, stated that 'Never Gonna Give You Up' was the second Stock, Aitken and Waterman production to reach number one in America. It's the third, following **Banaram's** 'Venus' and **Dead Or Alive's** 'You Spin Me Round (Like A Record)'. That was my fault as was crediting a **Dave Berry** hit to **Mike Berry**, but gremlins at the printers imposed other errors on my ramblings. Specifically, the list of Bu Bacharach hits was in the Chartfile section, when, in fact, it referred to British hits. And 'Tower Of Strength' was a Bacharach/Hilliard composition not Bacharach/David. In the same listing, the **Cryin' Shames** came across as Cryin' James. Lastly, the items about **Cher** and **Debbie Gibson** should have been shown as Chartfile USA, ... a not Chartfile UK. I have whipped editress Betty Page and sub-editor Kevin Murphy to within an inch of the lives.

They seemed to enjoy it, but still promise to pay more attention in future to ensure that the only errors in Chartfile are those that originate from my increasingly addled brain.
