THIS WEEK'S CHART

● **WHITNEY HOUSTON** has a set back

● **Pet Shop Boys** Neil Tennant and **Chris Lowe** collect their fourth number one single this week as 'Heart' soars from its debut position of number seven to take over pole position from **Aswad's** 'Don't Turn Around'.

The po-faced duo previously topped the chart in 1985 with 'West End Girls' and last year with 'It's A Sin' and 'Always On My Mind'. Their success puts the Pet Shop Boys in a three way tie with **Wham!** and the **Everly Brothers** as the only duos to have four number one hits, and in a four-way tie with **Wham!**, **Jam** and **Shakin' Stevens** as the only acts to have four number one singles this decade. Heading them all with five number ones is **Madonna**.

● **'Talk'** improves 11 notches to number 25, becoming **T'Pau's** fourth top 30 hit. It's a live, re-titled version of their second single, 'Intimate Strangers', which was released 10 months ago and stifled

badly, failing to make the top 200.

● Twenty one-year-old **Glen Goldsmith** is a charming, self-effacing Londoner who professes great admiration for the voice of **Luther Vandross**. But if you watch the very clever video for Glen's latest hit, 'Dreaming', carefully, you'll see him toasting a copy of Luther's compact disc 'Give Me The Reason'. Glen, whose only previous hit, 'I Won't Cry', peaked at number 34, is a little surprised by the number 16 success of 'Dreaming', and says he wouldn't have been upset to have been a one hit wonder. He's currently hard at work recording his debut album.

● In America, it's on course to become her record-breaking seventh number one in a row, but here 'Where Do Broken Hearts Go' has dipped from its peak position of number 14 to number 17 — something of a disappointment for **Whitney Houston**. Whitney's first

two albums have sold over a million copies in the UK, but her singles have been much less successful here than in America. Of her six number ones there to date, only 'Saving All My Love For You' and 'I Wanna Dance With Somebody (Who Loves Me)' have done equally well here. 'How Will I Know' and 'So Emotional' both peaked at number five, 'Greatest Love Of All' got to number eight and 'Didn't We Almost Have It All' gave up the battle at number 14.

● 'Freedom' was a title that proved successful for **Wham!** a few years ago. Now it's the title of the hit that puts **Alice Cooper** the individual ahead of Alice Cooper the group in terms on number of hits.

'Freedom' is the sixth solo hit for Cooper, born Vincent Furnier, but as yet none has got higher than number 44 in the chart. By contrasts, the five hits the group Alice Cooper registered between 1972 and 1974 all made the top 20.

● It's a banner week for heavy metal, with three veterans of the genre in the top 30. **Iron Maiden's** 17th and biggest hit 'Can I Play With

Madness' drifts from its peak of number three to number five, **AC/DC's** 18th hit 'That's The Way I Wanna Rock 'N' Roll' climbs to number 22 and **Def Leppard's** 'Armageddon It' debuts at number 28. It's the Sheffield metallurgists eighth hit in total and the fourth in their platinum album 'Hysteria', following 'Animal', which peaked number six, 'Pour Some Sugar On Me' (number 20) and 'Hysteria' (number 26).

● 'Pink Cadillac' accelerates to number 24 this week, to become biggest hit to date for 38-year-old **Natalie Cole**, eclipsing the number 32 success of her introductory hit 1975's 'This Will Be'.

'Pink Cadillac' was written by **Bruce Springsteen** and previously appeared as the B-side of his 19 top 10 hit 'Dancing In The Dark'. joins a succession of Springsteen songs successfully charted by others amongst them 'Fire', a hit for the **Pointer Sisters**, 'Because The Night' (**Patti Smith**), 'Dancing In The Dark' (**Big Daddy**) and 'Blinded By The Light' (**Manfred Mann**).
