THIS WEEK'S CHART

Wet Wet Wet hang on at number one for a third week with their charity single 'With A Little Help From My Friends', but **Kylie Minogue's** 'Got To Be Certain' is whittling away their lead, setting up a photo-finish for next week.

Kylie has almost finished work on her forthcoming debut album with writers/producers **Mike Stock**, **Latt Aitken** and **Pete Waterman** from which her next single will be 'Je Ne Sais Pourquoi'. Lead honcho Waterman has just started a 20 day sailing holiday off Kylie's native Australia, but there will be no let-up in output from the Hit Factory with three tracks each by **ick 1 ay**, **Bananarama**, **initta** and **Samantha Fox** in various stages of completion. They're also writing and recording a single with **Donna Summer**, which takes her back to her disco roots, and **Cliff Richard**.

Meanwhile, after peaking at number 53 last November in its original version, Waterman and colleague **Pete Hammond's** remix of 'Voyage Voyage' by French chanteuse **Desireless** advances 21 places this week to number 14.

The record is the second French language hit to reach the top 20 this year, emulating **Vanessa Paradis's** 'Joe Le Taxi'. With **Ofra Haza's** 'Im Nin'Alu' also reaching the chart's upper echelon, it may be that our resistance to foreign language hits is finally being broken down. Or maybe not. Either way, here's a trio of very worthy French records ready to test the climate.

Clemence Lhomme and **Olivier Defays** are **Blue Rotoir**. Their single 'Un Soir De Vie' tied with 'Joe Le Taxi' in a vote to establish France's favourite record

last year. Cool and breezy, Gallic and jazzy, it has just been released here by Carrere Records, and must stand an outside chance of success.

More likely to make the grade is the new single from the French Queen of Rock, **Guesch Patti**. 'Let Be Must The Queen' is Guesch's follow-up to her excellent debut single 'Etienne'. Its rather odd title is a Shakespearean quote, and if it's good enough for Will, it's good enough for the chart.

Prime contender amongst the trois disques Français, however is **France Gall's** 'Ella, Elle L'a'. France is a veteran of the French scene, and has had several number one hits there including a French version of **Elton John's** stirring 'Nobody Wins', performed as a duet with the man himself. 'Ella, Elle L'a', a tribute to **Ella Fitzgerald**, is rush released here next week, after topping the charts in France and in Germany where it is currently number one for the second week. The Germans have hitherto been more receptive to French discs than we have, and Guesch Patti's latest is also successful there, moving up 17 places to number 21.

The absence from the top 10 of Stock, Aitken and Waterman-related records is only temporary — several

of their discs are dotted around the remainder of the top 75, despite the success of Germany's own hit machine in the form of **Modern Talking** alumnus **Dieter Bohlen**.

Dieter wrote and produced the **Blue System** single 'My Bed Is Too Big' at number 11, the week's highest new entry 'House Of Mystic Lights' by **C C Catch**, erstwhile **Smokie** vocalist Chris Norman's number three hit, and 'She's A Lady', the surprise hit by former **Bay City Rollers** lead singer **Les McKeown**, which improves two places to number 40.

● 'Blue Monday' continues its residency at the top of the CD singles chart for a third week, the longest any single has managed to hold down the position since last December, when the Pet Shop Boys' 'Always On My Mind' managed a four week shutout. 'Blue Monday' is also the best-selling CD single since then, with approximately 15,000

copies sold to date.
