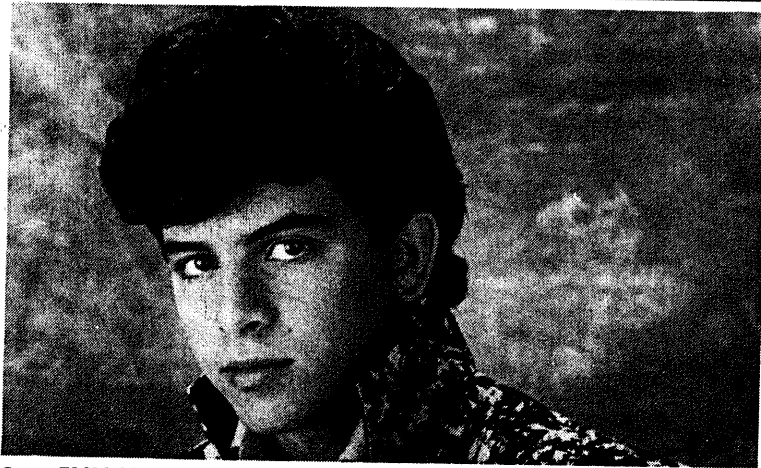

THIS WEEK'S CHART

Bros continue at number one in the singles chart for a second week with 'I Owe You Nothing', but their grip on the title is loosening, with the heavyweight threat — in more ways than one — coming from the **Fat Boys** and **Chubby Checker** who advance to number two with 'The Twist (Yo, Twist)', thus equalling the highest placing attained by the Fat Boys in their previous alliance with the **Beach Boys**, 'Wipeout'.

Chubby's original 1960 recording of 'The Twist' reached number 44 in 1960, number 14 in 1962 and number five in 1975, being paired on the latter occasion with another of his hits, 'Let's Twist Again'.

With **Sabrina's** 'Boys (Summertime Love)', **Phil Collins'** 'In The Air Tonight (Ben Liebrand Remix)' and the **Pasadenas** 'Tribute (Right On)' lined-up behind 'The Twist (Yo, Twist)' it's the most painful top five ever, with only Bros 'I Owe You Nothing' lacking brackets in its title — and even this was once mooted as 'I Owe You Nothing (Nothing At All)'.

Aside from the Fat Boys/Chubby Checker disc, the main challenge to Bros' continued occupation of the chart summit could come from **Glenn Medeiros**. When first released on the Mercury label last September, Glenn's 'Nothing's Gonna Change My Love For You' peaked at number 176. Now reissued on the London label, it's a major hit. This week it vaults 25 places for the second week in a row to come to rest at number 11.

18-year-old Glenn, from Hawaii, recorded the song — penned by **Michael Masser** and **Gerry Goffin**, who also teamed up to create **Whitney Houston's** number one smash 'Saving All My Love For You' — when 16. It was a number one hit in Hawaii as long ago as March 1987, and subsequently reached the US top ten last June, before becoming a hit in Scandinavia last Autumn, and in Southern Europe in the spring. It reached number one in France a few weeks ago, and is currently perched at the top of the charts in Holland.

'Nothing's Gonna Change My Love For You' was originally recorded by **George Benson** in 1984 for his album '20/20'.

● **Tracy Chapman** sets the seal on her rapid rise to fame this week, with her debut single, 'Fast Car', climbing to number ten, whilst her first, self-titled album takes over at the top of the album chart, becoming the first ever debut album by a woman soloist to reach number one if we accept that 'Alf' was not **Alison Moyet's** debut album, as she was already established as half of **Yazoo**. Tracy's album, though fairly eclectic, is indisputably a folk album, and, as such, it's the first to reach number one since 1972, this being the year in which **Tyrannosaurus Rex's** double reissue 'Prophets, Seers And Sages And Angels Of The Ages/My People Were Fair And Had Sky In Their Hair ... But Now They're Content To Wear Stars' topped the chart. Mention should be made here, however, of **Suzanne Vega's** 'Solitude Standing', which reached number two last year.

Whilst Tracy triumphs, the **Style Council** slide. After the failure of their latest single, 'Life At A Top People's Health Farm', to reach the top 20, their album, 'Confessions Of A Pop Group', debuts this week at a disappointing number 15. Unless it improves on this poor start — an unlikely event — it will break the group's sequence of top ten albums. Their debut, 'Cafe Bleu', got to number two in 1984. 'Our Favourite Shop' reached number one in 1985, 'Home And Abroad' peaked at number eight in 1986 and 'The Cost Of Loving' climbed to number two last year. With a playing time in excess of 57 minutes, 'Confessions Of A Pop Group' is the Style Council's longest album to date.

● **A-ha's** tenth single, 'The Blood That Moves The Body', dips to number 42 this week, after peaking at number 25. All the group's first nine singles made the top 20 — actually, they all made the top 13 — and though they deserve some credit for becoming only the second Scandinavian act in chart history to

accumulate as many as ten hits seem unlikely ever to challenge Abba's total of 25. Incidental appears to be no truth in the 'Abba to reform' rumours.

After bouncing up to number Sabrina's 'Boys (Summertime Love)' seems to have run out of steam matter, it's the highest placing attained by an Italian act since **Spagna's** 'Call Me' reached number two last September.

Sabrina's single is the biggest yet for its Milan-based producer **Claudio Cecchetto**, who was responsible for last year's 'I Love Radio', a number six hit for **Tina Turner**. Cecchetto, who also co-wrote 'Call Me' and 'Boys', could have another international smash on his hands with the debut single by Italian teen sensation **Jovanotti** who has been number one in three weeks with his debut single 'Gimme Five'.

LATE NEWS

● **UB40** bass player, **Earl**, has been jailed 1 month after causing death of his brother by less driving.

Birmingham Crown Court heard last week that **33-year-old Ray Falconer**, a sour griner with **UB40**, had been back seat passenger in a car which went out of control ploughing through a sign and a lamp post before smashing into a factory. The accident happened in November and tests showed that Earl had twice the amount of alcohol in his bloodstream.

Judge **Michael Dillon** sentenced Earl to 18 months in prison with 12 months suspended. He also banned Earl from driving for three years. Earl's sentence throws **U2's** forthcoming world tour in jeopardy, but as our press spokesman said: 'A final decision about the tour has yet to be taken.'
