# THIS WEEK'S CHART

### ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

 No change at the top of the singles chart again this week, with Glenn Medeiros's 'Nothing's Gonna Change My Love For You' triumphant for the third week in a row

Thus far, 'Nothing's Gonna Change My Love For You' has sold 400,000 copies and by today (Wednesday) it should have overtaken **Wet Wet Wet**'s 'With A Little Help From My Friends' to move into third place in the year-to-date chart, trailing **Tiffany**'s 'I Think We're Alone Now' in second place, and long-time leader **Kylie Minogue**'s 'I Should Be So Lucky'. All, will note, are debut singles by to agers.

• S-Express make a strong debut at number 20 with 'Superfly Guy'. Their previous hit, the number one single 'Theme From S-Express', entered the chart at number 25. And, further to my recent item on the latter track's popularity on compilation albums comes the news that it is the only track to appear on both 'Now That's What I Call Music 12' and 'Hits 8'.

'Hits 8' was released on Monday, whilst 'Now 12' debuts at number one this week, after selling over 170,000 copies in its first week in the shops. It's the 11th of the regular 'Now' series to reach number one, with 'Now 4' the only failure. 'Now 11' has sold over three quarters of a million copies since its release four months ago.

Amongst its 32 tracks, 'Now 12' fea six number one singles, including the current one by Glenn Medeiros, whilst the smallest hit it accommodates is **Elton John**'s number 30 disc 'I Don't Wanna Go On With You Like That'.

• 'Dirty Diana', **Michael Jackson**'s fifth single off 'Bad',
vaults 10 places to number four this
week with doubled sales, as the
country is seized by Jackson-mania.

By the time his tour is over, Jackson's dates at Wembley and elsewhere in Britain will have been attended by a million people. This will obviously translate into increased sales and, even at this early stage, the effect on some of Jackson's albums is quite marked.

\* 'Bad' bounced back to number five this week, its highest posting since January, after tripling its sales to 30,000 a week.

\* 'Thriller' improved 52 places to number 37. It too triples its sales to reach its highest chart position for nearly a year.

\* 1979's 'Off The Wall' more than doubled its sales in making a leap from number 88 to number 57. It last ventured this high in September 1984.

\* Stylus Record's 'Michael Jackson Mix' increased its sales fourfold as it raced from number 198 to number 65, making its best showing since March.

- Tracy Chapman's self-titled debut album may have been dethroned by 'Now 12', but she can console herself with the fact that it has now overtaken Belinda Carlisle's 'Heaven On Earth' as the best selling album of 1988 by a woman. Ms Chapman's album has so far sold more than 400,000 copies.
- Moving up strongly to number nine on this week's singles chart, 'Foolish Beat' is the fourth top 20 single off 18-year old **Debbie Gibson**'s debut album 'Out Of The Blue', following 'Shake Your Love' (number 7), 'Only In My Dreams' (number 11)

and the title track (number 19). Debbie's album has been in the chart continuously since it made its debut, a little belatedly, in January, and has sold over 100,000 copies so far, yet it has conspicuously failed to match the chart success of any of Debbie's singles, with a high to date of number 26.

 CD singles are now well on the way to being the norm, although they are still released in very small runs. Of this week's top 75 singles, 57 are already on CD single, whilst others will doubtless follow.
