THIS WEEK'S CHART

Yazz And The Plastic

Population remain at number one for a third week with 'The Only Way Is Up', and seem certain to have at least one more week on top, with the next number one looking increasingly likely to be one of three records which make impressive moves this week — **Breathe's** 'Hands To Heaven', which climbs 11 notches to number six, **Brother Beyond's** 'The Harder I Try', up 16 places to number eight or the **Julio Iglesias/Stevie Wonder** duet 'My Love', which soars from number 33 to number 17.

'The Only Way Is Up' has already sold over 350,000 copies and is destined to be a major hit all over Euro, where Yazz's previous single, 'Doctorin' The House', was very well received. In America, where 'Doctorin' The House' was recently released by CBS, it has yet to make the Hot 100, though it is number three in Billboard's Club Play Chart. Thus far, CBS has not managed to secure US rights to 'The Only Way Is Up', being one of five companies competing for the right to release it.

● After an absence of nearly two years, **Big Country** are back, making the week's highest new entry at number 24 with 'King Of Emotion'.

It's the Scottish group's twelfth hit — the same number as was achieved by the **Bay City Rollers**, who continue to hold the record for most sales by a Scottish group, even though their record for most hits has been hijacked by **Simple Minds**, who've charted 15 singles to date.

● Eleven years after 'Rockin' All Over The World' peaked at number three, **Status Quo's** re-recording of the song, now re-titled 'Running All Over The World' to mark its adoption as

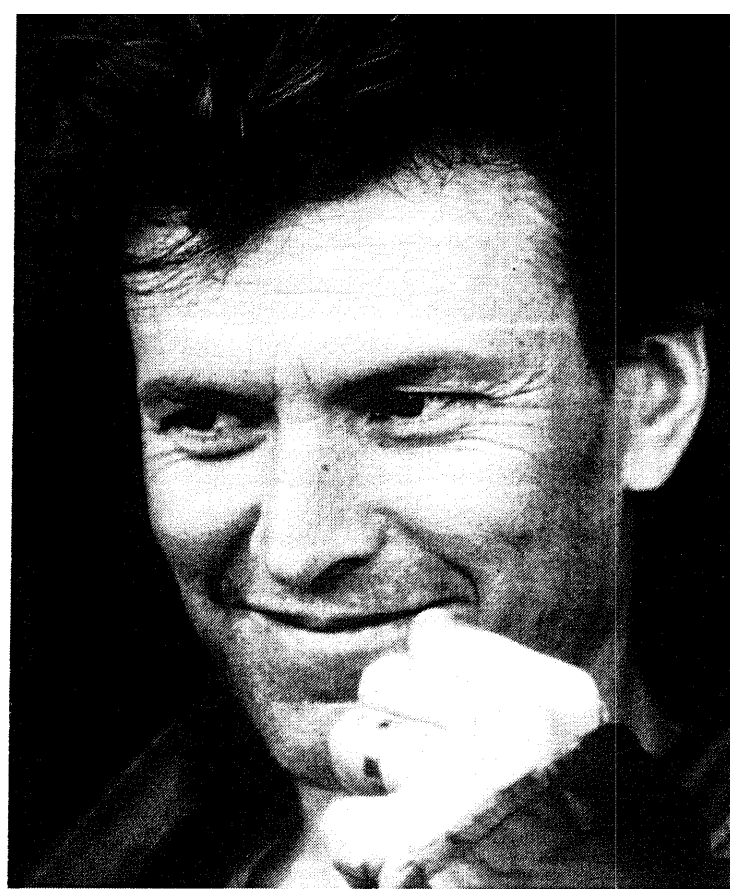
the 1988 Sport Aid anthem, debuts at number 30.

Quo is the second act to make a slight lyrical alteration to an earlier hit for Sport Aid, following the 1986 example of **Tears For Fears**, whose 'Everybody Wants To Rule The World' became a hit all over again as 'Everybody Wants To Run The World'.

It's also the second Quo hit from the Seventies that the band has re-recorded successfully in the Eighties; in 1982 they reached number 13 with a new version of their 1973 hit 'Caroline', recorded live at Birmingham's National Exhibition Centre. It remains the only hit recorded live in Britain's second city, speaking of which...

● Congratulations to Birmingham boy **Steve Winwood**. The talented singer/songwriter's 'Roll With It' is America's number one single for the fourth straight week — the longest run of the year. If that isn't reason enough to celebrate, Winwood also claims the top position on the album chart with his similarly-titled long-player, which has sold over 1,500,000 copies since it was released two months ago, whilst his new single, 'Don't You Know What The Night Can Do?', is the highest new entry on the Hot 100 at number 61.

'Roll With It' is Winwood's first number one album as a soloist, though he was lead singer on **Blind Faith's** one and only, self-titled, 1969 chart topper. The 19 years which have elapsed between the success of that album and 'Roll With It' give Winwood the questionable honour of taking longer than anyone else to score a number one solo album after earlier success as a group member. The previous record

holder was **John Fogerty**, who had a number one album in 1985 with his debut solo album 'Centerfield' some 16 years after his group **Creedence Clearwater Revival's** 'Green River' topped the chart in succession to... 'Blind Faith'. Winwood may find his grip on this particular record is rather shortlived. At least, that is, if American record buyers are as generous in their attitude to **Beach Boy Brian Wilson's** debut solo album as the critics have been.

Winwood has been a professional musician for a staggering 24 years, enjoying success with the **Spencer Davis Group** and **Traffic** before forming Blind Faith with **Eric Clapton, Ginger Baker** and **Rick Grech**, but he's never had success like this before.

At 40, Winwood is the oldest album chart topper in America since **Patti LaBelle**, then 42, topped just

over two years ago with 'Winne You'. Winwood's previous best showing as a soloist? The number three albums 'Arc Of A Diver' (1981) and 'Back In The High Life' (1982).

● Producer **John 'Jellybean' Benitez** has his fifth hit in under a year as 'Coming Back For More' debuts this week at number 51.

Though Jellybean is not a singer, 'Jingo' is the only one of his hits to be an instrumental, the remainder featuring guest vocalists.

Steven Dante sang on 'The Thing', **Elisa Fiorillo** vocalised 'Who Found Who' and **Adele Bertei** trilled 'Just A Mirage'. Jellybean's partner on 'Coming Back For More' is **Living In A Box's** **Richard Darbyshire**. The song was co-written by **Toni C**, who penned **Whitney Houston's** 'I Will Save The Day', admittedly off-day.
