THIS WEEK'S CHARTS

ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

With both records registering a drop in sales after surging the week before, the **Hollies** 'He Ain't Heavy, He's My Brother' pulls ahead of **Phil Collins** 'A Groovy Kind Of Love' to become the new number one single.

It's probably true to say that had the 'Buster' soundtrack album, on which 'A Groovy Kind Of Love' appears, not been released last week, then it is very unlikely that the Hollies would be number one — 'Buster' sold over 23,000 copies last week, and deflected sales from 'A Groovy Kind Of Love', which sold only 3,000 fewer copies than 'Heavy'. The Hollies have another reason to be at happy at the success of 'Buster' — their 1964 number two hit 'Just One Look' is also included on the album.

In first released in 1969, 'He Ain't Heavy, He's My Brother' reached number three in a 15 week chart career. This time around, it reached number one on its fourth week of chart combat. In total, therefore it has taken 19 weeks to reach number one, thus equalling the record established by the similarly split chart career of **Jackie Wilson**'s 'Reet Petite' in December 1986. The record for most consecutive weeks on the chart before reaching number one — an arguably more impressive achievement — remains in the hands of **Jennifer Rush**, whose 'The Power Of Love' finally ascended to number one in 1985 on its 16th attempt.

Only two recordings have been older than 'Heavy' when they reached number one — 'Reet Petite' was nearly 30 years old when it topped the chart as detailed above, and **Ben E King**'s 'Stand By Me' was 25 years old when it reached number one in February 1987.

'Heavy' is the Hollies' second number one. Their first was 'I'm Alive' in 1965. They therefore establish new records for both the longest span of number one singles by an act — beating **Elvis Presley**'s 20 year (1957-1977) span between number one singles, eclipsing the

14½ year record created by **Diana Ross** when she topped with 'Chain Reaction' in 1986.

One final link between the Hollies and Phil Collins is that both had 1983 US hits with remakes of **Supremes** number ones, Phil reaching number 10 with his UK chart topper 'You Can't Hurry Love', and the Hollies reaching number 29 with 'Stop! In The Name Of Love'.

★ **Gloria Estefan and Miami Sound Machine**'s 'Anything For You' finally cracked the top 10 last week after an unusually slow 10 week ascent of the chart. A real 'sleeper', it debuted on 16 July at number 53, and has since logged the following positions: 56-49-49-47-34-25-19-15-10-11. Only one of the group's previous singles reached the top 10 in Britain — 'Dr Beat', which reached number six in 1984.

In America, the sultry Ms Estefan and her cohorts are big business — their latest album, 'Let It Loose', has sold over 2,500,000 copies and has yielded four top 10 hit singles. 'Rhythm Is Gonna Get You' got to number five, 'Can't Stay Away From You' reached number six, 'Anything For You' went all the way to number one and '1-2-3' peaked at number three. In Britain, where '1-2-3' has yet to be released, 'Can't Stay Away From You' got to number 88, and 'Rhythm Is Gonna Get You' — a song much favoured at Chartfile Towers — reached a miserable number 107.
