# THIS WEEK'S CHARTS

ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

**The Hollies** 'He Ain't Heavy, He's My Brother' remains at number one this week, after establishing a comfortable lead over **Phil Collins**' 'A Groovy Kind Of Love', but can expect to come under threat next week from 'Desire', the first single from **U2**'s much awaited movie/album 'Rattle And Hum', which enters at number three. It is the group's highest debuting single to date, and their fifth to make its initial appearance inside the top 10, beating 'Pride (In The Name Of Love)' which entered at number eight on 15 September 1984, 'The Unforgettable Fire', which matched that position on 4 May 1985, and a pair of singles that each entered at number four — 'With Or Without You' (28 March 1987) and 'Where The Streets Have No Name' (12 September 1987). 'Desire' sold over 60,000 copies last week, even though it was only available on seven inch. This week, with the release of its 12 inch counter part (2½ minutes longer) and a 'Top Of The Pops' screening for the video, it should do much better, and could conceivably give the group its first ever number one single.

'A Little Respect' becomes the third consecutive top 20 hit off **Erasure**'s album 'The Innocents' this week, entering the listings at number 19, and equalling the record high debut of the duo's last single 'Chains Of Love'. 'Ship Of Fools', the first single off the album, debuted at number 20.

The success of 'A Little Respect' helps 'The Innocents' to make a 20 rung jump on the album chart this week. The album, a former number one, has thus far sold over 320,000 copies.

**Sabrina**'s single 'All Of Me' debuts at number 51 this week, enabling **Mike Stone**, **Matt Aitken** and **Pete Waterman** to establish two new chart records.

As songwriters, they are responsible for simultaneous hits by six different acts; as producers their haul is seven hits. Both

achievements are unique in the annals of chart history.

As songwriters and producers, **SAW** are behind the hits by **Sabrina**, **Jason Donovan**, **Bananarama**, **Brother Beyond**, **Hazell Dean** and **Sinitta**. They also produced **Kylie Minogue**'s update of the **Goffin** and **King**-penned 'The Loco-Motion'.

Meanwhile, **Rick Astley**, whose first four singles were written and/or produced by **SAW** scores his fifth straight top 10 single with the self-penned 'She Wants To Dance With Me', which he also had a hand in producing with **Phil Harding** and **Ian Curnow**, two eminent members of **Waterman's PWL** team.

**Whitney Houston** registers her biggest hit of the year as 'One Moment In Time' charges from number 24 to number eight this week; 'Where Do Broken Hearts Go' stalled at number 14, and 'Love Will Save The Day' made number 10. 'One Moment In Time' is taken from

the Arista album of the same name, released to tie-in with American TV network **NBC's** coverage of the Olympic Games. The album includes the **Four Tops**' current hit 'Indestructible', the **Christians**' revival of the **Isley Brothers**' 'Harvest For The World', which will be a hit in a couple of weeks, and **Jermaine Jackson** and **LaLa**'s sparse but melodic reading of the **Climie Fisher** hit 'Rise To The Occasion'.

**Bon Jovi**'s 'New Jersey' album debuts at number one this week, becoming the first hard rock album to reach pole position since **Def Leppard**'s 'Hysteria' held the crown 13 months ago.

None of **Bon Jovi**'s three previous albums reached number one. 'Bon Jovi' peaked at number 71, '7800° Fahrenheit' climbed to number 28 and 'Slippery When Wet' peaked at number six.

'New Jersey' sold more than 60,000 copies last week, but needs to spin-off a succession of hits of the magnitude of the current 'Bad Medicine' if it is to match 'Slippery When Wet' which has sold over 579,000 copies since its 1986 release.

## CHARTFILE USA

The 38-year-old **Bobby McFerrin** soared to the top of the US singles chart last week with his debut hit 'Don't Worry, Be Happy'. The record, which simultaneously entered the British chart last week at number 69, and this week is

the fastest climber moving up to number 25 is, like all **Bobby's** recordings over the last few years, completely acappella, and noises, however unlikely, originating from him or on the singer's body.

'Don't Worry ...' is taken from **Bob**'s latest album 'Simple Pleasures', where the multi-talented jazz singer's entertaining acappella adaptations are applied to a range of cover versions, including **the Beatles**' 'Drive My Car', **the Rascals**' 'Good Lovin' and **Cream**'s 'Sunshine In Your Love', as well as a handful of self-penned numbers, amongst them 'Don't Worry, Be Happy', all custom built to demonstrate the range, diversity and virtuosity of **McFerrin**.

Though we've had a couple of acap number ones in this country, via **the Flying Pickets**' 'Only You' and **the Housemartins**' 'Caravan Of Love', **McFerrin's** is the first unaccompanied number one in the 48-year-history of US charts. And, the only other acappella recording to hit the top 20 in the last decade — during which time over 1.5 records have made the grade — is a revival of 'Na Na Hey Hey Kiss Him Goodbye' by the Canadian group **the Nylons**. It was a number 12 hit last year.

Going back still further, **Judy Collins**' 'Amazing Grace' reached number 15 in 1971, whilst **Prelude** fell just short of top 20 — at number 22 — in 1974 with their reading of **Neil Young's** song 'The Goldrush'.
