# THIS WEEK'S CHARTS

ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

● Only seven days after **U2** finally added their name to the rollcall of acts to have a number one hit, the song that got them there — 'Desire' — dips to number two, conceding pole position to 'One Moment In Time', the third number one by **Whitney Houston**, following 1985's 'Saving All My Love For You' and 1987's 'I Wanna Dance With Somebody (Who Loves Me)'.

Whitney is only the third female solo star to score a hat trick of chart toppers, joining **Sandie Shaw**, who completed the feat as long ago as 1967, and **Madonna**, who reached the target in 1986, and has since increased her tally to five.

'Moment' is the fourth number one penned by **Albert Hammond**, who co-wrote the song with **John Bettis**, followed by 1977's 'When I Need You' (which he wrote with **Carole Bayer Sager**) for **Leo Sayer**, 'Nothing's Gonna Stop Us Now', a number one hit for **Starship** last year, written with **Dianne Warren**, and 'Don't Turn Around', also written with Ms Warren, and a number one single for **Aswad** earlier this year. 'Moment' is the first number one hit of **Bettis'** career, though he wrote a number two hit, the **Carpenters'** 'Yesterday Once More' all of 15 years ago.

'Moment' was the second single off the Arista Records album of the same name, an album comprising entirely of tracks originally recorded for America's NBC-TV's coverage of the recent Olympic Games. The first, the **Four Tops'** 'Indestructible', peaked at number 55, whilst the third, the **Christians'** 'Harvest For The World' debuts strongly this week at number 21. Due next: 'Fight (No Matter How Long)', by the **Bunburys**, whose name conceals the teaming of **Eric Clapton** and the **Bee Gees**. Despite the fact that the album also includes tracks by **Taylor Dayne**, **Jennifer Holliday** and **Eric Carmen**, amongst others, its sales to date have been very disappointing, and it is currently languishing at number 112 in the chart, though it seems likely to finally

break into the Top 100 next week.

**Whitney Houston** and the **Christians** have more in common than just appearing on the 'One Moment In Time' album. Both have recorded songs written and originally recorded by the **Isley Brothers**. Ms Houston's multi-platinum 'Whitney' includes her serene update of the Isleys' 'For The Love Of You', a recording which remains only an album track, though many critics, myself included, find it infinitely preferable to the singles thus far lifted from the album, whilst the **Christians'** current hit was originally a number 10 hit for the Isleys in 1976.

● 'Harvest For The World' is not the only Isley Brothers' song in the current chart, **Salt-n-Pepa's** number 32 single 'Shake Your Thang (It's Your Thing)' having been originated by the Isleys in 1969.

Several other songs first recorded by the Isley Brothers have been hits for others. 'Twist And Shout' was a number four hit for **Brian Poole** and the **Tremeloes** in 1963. 'Shout' was a number seven hit for **Lulu** in 1964. 'This Old Heart Of Mine (Is Weak For You)' was a number four hit for **Rod Stewart** in 1975 and offshoot group **Isley Jasper Isley's** 'Caravan Of Love' was a number one for the **Housemartins** a couple of years ago. The best version of 'Harvest For The World' **not** committed to vinyl was performed by the **Style Council** on the Two Ronnies TV show about three years ago, with **Paul Weller** and **Dee C Lee** on form and sharing vocals.

Other Isley Brothers songs suitable for covering by would-be-hitmakers include 'Who Loves You Better' from 1976. 'Live It Up' from 1974, 'Lay Away' from 1972 and 'Freedom' from 1970. The last named is not the same song as recorded by **Wham!** on their album 'Make It Big', though the track that follows it — 'If You Were There' — is indeed a cover of an Isley Brothers song first heard on their 1981 album '3 & 3'.

● **Bon Jovi's** 'New Jersey' climbs to number one in America's album chart this week, but, after a fortnight on top in the UK, it is replaced here by 'Flying Colours', the first number one album of **Chris De Burgh's** career.

'Flying Colours' is the tenth album by Chris, who was born in Argentina to British parents, and is now a resident of Ireland. Of these, eight have made the chart, each trumping the peak of its predecessors.

'Spanish Train And Other Stories'

(1975) got to number 78, albeit 10 years after it was released, 'Crusader' (1979) reached number 72, 'Best Moves' (1981) reached number 65, 'The Getaway' (1982) reached number 30, 'Man On The Lion' (1982) reached number 11, 'The Very Best Of Chris De Burgh' (1984) reached number six and 'Into The Light' (1986) reached number two. Neither 'At The End Of A Perfect Day' (1977) or 'East Wind' (1980) bothered the chart compilers.

## ● STOP PRESS

CBS Records are denying that **Public Enemy** member **Professor Griff** was barred from entering Britain on Sunday because he was carrying a knife.

**Public Enemy**, who have become infamous for parading around with machine guns as part of their stage act, still played the opening night of the tour at the Brixton Academy with **Run DMC**; but later **Chuck D** told **rm** correspondent Malu Halasa that Professor Griff had not been allowed through British immigration at Heathrow Airport for failing to declare he was carrying a knife. He also claimed that two members from **Public Enemy's** entourage (it is **SIW's** had also been refused entry).

However, CBS, who distribute **Public Enemy's** Def Jam label in Britain, say that because a Concorde flight was overbooked, Professor Griff couldn't travel with the rest of the group for the Brixton Academy show, but he and **SIW's** were due to arrive in Britain on Monday.
