THIS WEEK'S CHARTS

ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

● **Soul II Soul's** 'Back To Life (However Do You Want Me)' remains at number one for a third week, but its days look numbered, with three contenders shaping up to make a challenge next week, these being

● **The Beautiful South**, whose 'Song For Whoever' advances from number three to number two. Should it reach number one, it will complete a notable double for group member **Paul Heaton**, who topped the chart in December 1986 with 'Caravan Of Love' is a member of **the Housemartins**. Heaton's co-vocalist in the Beautiful South, **Dave Hemmingsway**, was also a housemartin, but not until 1987).

● **London Boys**, whose 'London Nights' falls from its debut position of number 19 to number three, topping the number four peak scaled by their debut it 'Requiem' less than two months ago.

● **The Pet Shop Boys**, whose new single 'It's Alright' is the week's highest new entry, exploding onto the chart at number five. Originally a number 53 hit or its writer **Sterling Vold** in February, it's the seventh Pet Shop Boys single to debut inside the top 10. Only one — 'Always On My Mind' — has entered higher, making its first appearance at number four on 12 December 1987. The other five Pet Shop Boys discs to now inside the top 10: 'It's A Sin' (entered number five on 27 June 1987), 'Heart' (number seven, 2 April 1988), 'Left To My Own Devices' (number seven, 26 November 1988), 'Domino Dancing' (number nine, 24 September 1988) and with **Dusty Springfield** 'What Have Done To Deserve This' (number 10, 22 August 1987).

Farewell then to 'Ferry' 'Cross The Mersey', which slips out of the chart this

week after just seven weeks on the listings, the first three of which it spent at number one.

'Ferry' thus equals the record for fewest weeks on the chart by a number one single. Of the 630 number ones since the chart was introduced in 1952, only two have had chart careers as short as 'Ferry' — **Dickie Valentine's** 1955 offering 'Christmas Alphabet' and **Ferry Aid's** 1987 topper 'Let It Be'. All three are novelties of a sort, which partly explains the brevity of their popularity. 'Christmas Alphabet' was a seasonal hit (no, surely not, you cry) whilst 'Let It Be' and 'Ferry' 'Cross The Mersey' were both fast-selling charity discs. The chart was only 20 titles deep when 'Christmas Alphabet' was a hit, so its decline was nowhere near as hasty as the other two discs, which have worked their way out of the top 75 just as quickly. Both were produced by **Stock, Aitken and Waterman**.

● **Guns N' Roses'** new single 'Patience' climbs 12 places to number 10, whilst their previous single 'Sweet Child O' Mine' dips from number 12 to number 20. They therefore become the first act to have two singles in the top 20 at the same time since January 1988, when **Jellybean** was represented by both 'Who Found Who' and 'Jingo'.

● As I said last week, **Samantha Fox** has had her knockers, and one of them is **Sabrina**, with whom she has had a well-publicised bust-up.

Last week, as Sam's latest disc slipped out of the chart, Sabrina replaced her with 'Like A Yo-Yo'.

Sabrina thus completes, albeit in reverse, a journey previously undertaken by **Donna Summer**.

Donna's early hits were written and produced (with collaborators) by **Giorgio Moroder**, whilst she now depends on Stock, Aitken and Waterman to provide her with chart fodder. Sabrina

scored with SAW's 'All Of Me (Boy Oh Boy)' last year, whilst 'Like A Yo Yo' was penned for her by fellow Italian Moroder.

In the world of catalogue numbers, few have been more appropriate than Sabrina's latest — DCUP 1!

On a similar note, it's interesting to note that though Arista are prohibited from mentioning the group **Yes** when advertising the self-penned **Anderson Bruford Wakeman Howe** album (because the name Yes is owned by other individuals who passed through the band) in America, they have given the quartet's album the catalogue number 90126. The

significance of this? Yes recorded an album for the Atco label in 1983 entitled '9012'.

The Yes link is reinforced by the fact that the Anderson Bruford Wakeman Howe album's artwork is by **Roger Dean**, whose work is closely identified with Yes. One can sympathise with Anderson et al. They were, after all, the sole members of Yes when they record their global best sellers 'Fragile' and 'Close To The Edge' back in the Seventies. This fact seems to have got through to the fact of the group — the Anderson Bruford Wakeman Howe album debuts at number 14 this week.
