ready installed as the best-selling single the year, Jive Bunny and the astermixers's 'Swing The Mood' mpletes a fifth week at the top of the art to become the longest running mber one hit since Yazz and the lastic Population's 'The Only Way Up' completed a similar stint a year ago. The odds are heavily stacked against the e Bunny single spending another week the summit — the last record to hold it for six weeks was Stevie 'onder's 'I Just Called To Say I Love ou' way back in 1984.

'I Just Don't Have The Heart' climbs om numer 10 to number three, to come wiff Richard's third top three in a row. At a time when Cliff might expected to be in the twilight of his reer, that's his best run since 1962/63 nen he registered seven top three igles one after the other.

Queen, meanwhile, prove less

ccessful. Their latest single, 'The Invisible an', dips from its peak position of mber 12 to number 16. The third single I their album 'The Miracle', it therefore is to emulate the top 10 success of the st two. Though they've had some assive hits, and reached the top 10 a tal of 17 times - more than any other oup except the Beatles, the piling Stones, Status Quo and **bba** — their longest sequence of nsecutive top 10 hits remains the three a row they scored in 1975 and equalled 1984. 'The Invisible Man' failed to make e grade even though it included the nreleased 'Hijack My Heart' on eviou

Liza Minnelli's 'Losing My Mind'. Debuting at number 24 three weeks ago, it immediately soared to number six, and then slipped to number seven. This week it makes a more noticeable decline, falling to number 14. There is no doubt that Gallup's assessment of the record's relative popularity is accurate, and the only consternation at Liza's record company, CBS, is due to the record's inability to maintain its early impetus, and not to any shortcomings of the Gallup chart system. Contrast that with the bizarre behaviour of the record in the Nescafe-sponsored Network Chart whch runs on the Independent Local Radio Network at the same time as the Beeb unveils the Gallup chart. "The Nettle", as it is vulgarly referred to, had 'Losing My Mind' as a new entry only a fortnight ago at number 14. Last week, it was up to number two, and, seemingly, set fare to top the chart. Instead, it sinks to number seven on the latest chart. In all my years of chartwatching I have never seen a more dramatic or unlikely reversal.

● Madonna, Jason Donovan and Cliff Richard will all have different ideas, but **Tears For Fears** signalled their intentions of scoring their first ever number one hit with their Beatles' pastiche 'Sowing The Seeds Of Love', which debuted at number nine this week.

Their first single for over three years, it is also the highest debuting of their 12 hits, beating the number 13 entry of 1986's 'Everybody Wants To Run The World', which, ironically, replaced 'Everybody Wants To Rule The World', a number 16 newcomer the previous year. Only one other TFF single has entered the chart inside the top 20 — 1983's 'Change', which made its bow at number 19.

● The Beatmasters' 'Hey DJ/I Can't Dance To That Music You're Playing' climbs another four notches this week, coming to rest at number seven. It is their fourth consecutive top 20 hit, and each features a different guest vocalist — a unique achievement.

Their introductory hit 'Rok Da House', which got to number five 18 months ago, was rapped by the Cookie Crew. The follow-up 'Burn It Up', a number 14 hit last Autumn, featured veteran vocalist P P Arnold. Merlin weaved his magic on their third single 'Who's In The House', which climbed to number eight in May, and their current hit features rapper Betty Boo and singer Claudia Fontaine. All four hits are included on the Beatmasters' debut album 'Anywayawanna', as is the track tipped by many as their next single, 'Midnight Girl', which features yet another vocalist, namely Eric Robinson. His name may not be familiar, but Robinson has already had two hits this year fronting other bands. He shed his surname first to help out the Beatmasters' label-mates S'Express on 'Hey Music Lover', which was credited to S'Express featuring Eric and Billy, and followed-up with Eric & The Good Good Feeling's 'Good Good Feeling'.

which, although only a minor success here,

recently made the Dutch top 20 and is currently a hit in Belgium and Germany.

• Big Fun's remake of 'Blame It On The Boogie' appeared to have run out c steam when it stayed at number eight la week — but it was only pausing. This week it climbs to number six, thus eclipsing the number eight peak of the Jacksons' 1978 version of the song which was also a number 15 hit for its writer Mick (no relation) Jackson.

The success of Big Fun's version of the song justifies their record company Jive's decision to rush release the single ahead of the previously scheduled and promoe 'I Feel The Earth Move', a Hi-NRG revamp of a song written and first recorded by **Carole King** on her classic album 'Tapestry'.

But Jive may come to regret delaying the release of 'I Feel The Earth Move', which has, coincidentally, been covered, also in a Hi-NRG version, by the artist currently occupying the chart berth immediately above Big Fun — **Martik**: Her recording of 'I Feel The Earth Move is already in the US Hot 100, and her record company is currently deciding whether to make it her next single here, or to try again with her earlier flop 'Mor Than You Know'.
