● THE CHRISTIANS: "Cheers, I'll have a pint of Tizer and Guinness"

300,000. The LP, which contains two fewer tracks has sold only 200,000 copies.

The continued reign of '... But Seriously' must make **Jive Bunny And The Mastermixers** hopping mad. Their 'Jive Bunny — The Album' has spent the last three weeks at number two, while selling well over half a million copies.

● 'Dear Jessie' edges up to number seven, furthering **Madonna's** lead at the top of three categories we use to measure popularity. Maddy has had more top 10 singles, more weeks in the top 10 and has sold more singles than any other act this decade.

● Assuming 'Do They Know It's Christmas' remains at number one next week (it will), the final year of the Eighties will have yielded 18 number one singles — the lowest annual total since 1984, when a mere 15 singles topped the chart. In the Eighties as a whole, 191 different singles have been number one, compared to 169 in the Seventies and 186 in the Sixties.

● **Max Bygraves'** version of 'White Christmas' drifts to number 75 this week. The eight versions of the song to chart have so far amassed 36 weeks on the chart, with the main contribution — or of nine weeks — coming from **Bing Crosby**. No other Xmas song has managed to chart for so long, though special mention should be made of **Slade's** original studio recording of 'Merry Xmas Everybody', which has accumulated a magnificent tally of 29 weeks on the chart, while a live version they recorded at the Reading Festival I also spent a couple of weeks in the chart. Band Aid's 'Do They Know It's Christmas' — original version — has also had a h creditable 20 week chart career.

CHRISTMAS CHARTS

Due to Xmas deadlines we will be carrying the US Singles and LP charts, Indie Singles and LP charts, US Black Singles and the Music Video chart for week December 17-23 in our next issue dated January 6, 1990.

George, Paul Young, Simon Le Bon and **George Michael**. The Band Aid II hit has a less stellar line-up, including **Kylie Minogue, Jason Donovan, Bros, Big Fun, Sonia, Cliff Richard, Lisa Stansfield, Wet Wet Wet, The Pasadenas, Chris Rea, Jimmy Somerville** and **Technotronics** on the sleeve of the single. These careless spelling mistakes must be a little annoying for them, although even Technotronic's own press officer has managed to pluralise their name no fewer than five times on a press release for their new album.

Bananarama's Sarah Dallin and **Keren Woodward** are the only artists to have contributed to both Band Aid discs.

● 'Sister' by Bros jumps 20 places to number 12 this week, to become the **Goss Brothers'** first chart-climber since 'I Owe You Nothing' over 18 months ago. Since then, all their singles have peaked in their debut positions.

● 'You Surround Me' crashes from its peak of number 15 to number 22 this week. It's **Erasure's** least successful chart record since 'Who Needs Love Like That' peaked at number 55 in 1985. 'You Surround Me' follows nine consecutive top 12 hits for the duo of **Andy Bell** and **Vince Clarke**.

● **Phil Collins'** '... But Seriously' spends its fourth consecutive week at the top of the album chart, and shows no sign of relinquishing its title. Phil's album should pass its millionth sale some time this week — of which half will be accounted for by the cassette version alone, with the compact disc weighing in with a hefty

As we all knew it would, **Band Aid II's** 'remake of 'Do They Know It's Christmas' debuts at number one this week, but less emphatically than we anticipated, after selling less than 200,000 copies in a week. The original Band Aid recording of the song also debuted at number one in 1985, selling upwards of 750,000 copies in the week of its release.

'Do They Know It's Christmas' is the only song to top the charts twice in the Eighties, and the 13th in chart history. It is the 12th number one produced by **Stock Aitken Waterman** — a total beaten only by **George Martin** and **Norrie Paramor** (27 each), **Mitc** 'filler (17) and **Steve Scho** (15) — but Band Aid II is the tenth different SAW act to have a number one, — a record no previous production team can match.

'Do They Know It's Christmas' is the 22nd single to debut at number one in chart history, and the fourth this year, which thus rivals 1973 as the year for most number one debuts. 'Do They Know It's Christmas' is the third single to debut at number one by dethroning another number one debutant — the first was **Slade's** 'Merry Xmas Everybody', which overtook **Gary Glitter's** 'I Love You, Love Me Love' in 1973 and the second was 'Ferry 'Cross The Mersey' the **Christians/Gerry Marsden/Paul McCartney/Holly Johnson** single that replaced **Jason Donovan's** 'Sealed With A Kiss' at number one earlier this year — but never before have singles debuted at number one on consecutive weeks — 'Let's Party' and 'Do They Know It's Christmas' have in the past fortnight.

Among the artists donating their talents to the first Band Aid number one were **Phil Collins, Bono, Sting, Boy**
