CHARTS

THIS WEEK'S CHART
ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES



● **SINÉAD O'CONNOR**: "This short hair might look good, but it's bleedin' cold in winter"

After just one week at the summit, **Kylie Minogue's** 'Tears On My Pillow' is replaced by **Sinéad O'Connor's** 'Nothing Compares 2 U'.

'Nothing' is the second number one single written by **Prince**, following 'I Feel For You', a chart topper for **Chaka Khan** in 1984. Both songs lay undiscovered and underappreciated for nearly five years before becoming hits — 'I Feel For You' originally appearing on Prince's self-titled 1980 album and 'Nothing Compares 2 U' debuting on the **The Family's** 'The Family' in 1985.

O'Connor is the ninth artist from the Republic of Ireland to reach number one — a tally bettered only by Brits and Americans. She follows **The Bachelors**, **Dana**, **Gilbert O'Sullivan**, **Johnny Logan**, **The Boomtown Rats**, **Chris De Burgh**, **U2** and **Enya**. (Note that **Ruby Murray** and **Fergal Sharkey**, who have also had number ones, are excluded from this count as they both hail from Northern Ireland, which, to the chagrin of many of its inhabitants, is still part of the UK.)

● **Rod Stewart's** 'Downtown Train' comes to a halt in America after reaching number three. It has been overtaken by **Paula Abdul's** 'Opposites Attract', which surges from number eight to number two. And in Britain, 'Downtown Train' is already running out of steam. This week it dips from number 43 to number 45. The song, written by **Tom Waits**, also appears on the CD and 12-inch versions of 'Driving' as interpreted by **Everything But The Girl**. It's not the first time EBTG have re-recorded a song identified with Rod. Two years ago, their version of Rod's 1977 chart topper,

'I Don't Want To Talk About It' climbed as high as number three.

● Highest new entry this week is **Technotronic's** 'Get Up (Before The Night Is Over)', which debuts impressively at number three. The Belgian group's only previous release, 'Pump Up The Jam', made a much quieter first impression, entering the chart at number 53 last September, before becoming one of the year's biggest hits.

Meanwhile, the highest new entry in America this week is 'Keep It Together', the fifth single off **Madonna's** 'Like A Prayer' album. It's the lowest debuting single yet off the album, entering at number 56, one notch lower than Maddy's last single 'Oh Father'. Her current UK success, 'Dear Jessie', has still to be released as a single in America.

● Overtaken last week by **The Christians' 'Colour'**, **Phil Collins' '... But Seriously'** returns to the top of the album chart this week to register its ninth week in pole position. Phil's three number one albums have spent a total of 17 weeks at number one, more than any other soloist except **Elvis Presley**, **Cliff Richard**, **Rod Stewart**, **Bob Dylan**, **Elton John** and **David Bowie**. Phil has also spent eight weeks at number one with **Genesis**.

And, though released too late to beat **Jason Donovan's** '10 Good Reasons' and **Simply Red's** 'A New Flame' in the battle to be the best selling album of 1989, '... But Seriously' did manage to become the best-selling CD of the year. The remainder of the Top 10, with overall 1989 rankings in brackets: 2 (2) **A NEW FLAME** — **Simply Red**; 3 (12) **THE ROAD TO HELL** — **Chris Rea**; 4

(8) **FOREIGN AFFAIR** — **Tina Turner**; 5 (7) **THE RAW AND THE COOKED** — **The Fine Young Cannibals**; (6) (5) **CUTS BOTH WAYS** — **Gloria Estefan**; 7 (4) **ANYTHING FOR YOU** — **Gloria Estefan & Miami Sound Machine**; 8 (18) **STREET FIGHTING YEARS** — **Simple Minds**; 9 (19) **THE MIRACLE** — **Queen**, 10 (9) **LIKE A PRAYER** — **Madonna**.

Though number one overall, Jason Donovan's '10 Good Reasons' was 38th in the CD chart. On the other hand, it sold over a million copies on cassette, a feat first achieved by **Dire Straits' 'Brothers In Arms'**, and subsequently only equalled by **Michael Jackson's** 'Bad' and 'Thriller' and 'Kylie — The Album'.

● **House Of Love's** latest single 'Shine On' enters the chart at number 22 easily beating their previous highest debut, attained last April when 'Never' made its maiden appearance at number 41. 'Shine On' is a remake of House Of Love's first

single. Released on the Creation label 1987, it failed to chart.

● Another group shattering its personal best is **Birdland**, whose latest single 'Sleep With Me' makes its debut at number 32 this week.

Impressive? Yes, especially when you consider that the group's only two previous chart records, 'Hollow Heart' and 'Paradise', both debuted at number 70 last year only to disappear the following week.

● 'To Know Someone Deeply Is To Know Someone Softly' croons **Tere Trent D'Arby** on the second single off his latest album 'Neither Fish Nor Flesh'. Unfortunately for Tezza, his belief that this is one of the best songs he has ever written would appear not to be shared by record buyers, as it dips to number 74 this week, having apparently peaked at number 55. Still, it has fare little better than 'This Side Of Love', an introductory single from the album, which peaked at number 83 last November

NEWS EXTRA SIGUE SIGUE SISTER

In a surprise move, **Tony James of Sigue Sigue Sputnik** has joined **Sisters Of Mercy**, replacing Patricia Morrison. Patricia has left to work a new project and The Sisters will also be adding guitarist Andreas Bruhl to the line up, although no further details are known about him at the moment. With James joining The Sisters Of Mercy it seems likely that Sigue Sigue Sputnik have split up, but as **Record Mirror** went to press, there was no official confirmation of this.
