CHARTS

THIS WEEK'S CHART
ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

● The singles chart has snapped out of its post-Christmas sales slump in dramatic style. Last week, **Sinéad O'Connor's** 'Nothing Compares 2 U' sold nearly 120,000 copies — four times as many as **New Kids On The Block's** 'Hangin' Tough' sold when it reached number one four weeks ago. Even **Technotronic's** 'Get Up' — at number two this week — is selling twice as quickly as 'Hangin' Tough' did.

● Lead vocals on each of this week's top six singles are handled by women — a new record. The previous record of five was set on 15 November 1986 (when **Berf** were number one, followed by **Kim Wilde, The Bangles, Mel & Kim** and **Swing Out Sister**) and equalled last week.

● And for the second week in a row the top three singles are by acts from Ireland, Belgium and Australia. Never before in chart history has the top three failed to include at least one act from Britain or America. Last week, each of the top six singles were by acts of different nationalities, equalling a record established on 16 October 1976, when the Netherlands' **Pussycat** led from **Abba** (Sweden), **Rod Stewart** (UK), **Sherbert** (Australia), **Demis Roussos** (Greece) and **Rick Deos and His Cast Of Idiots** (USA).

● After appearing to have peaked a fortnight ago at number 43, Rod Stewart's 'Downtown Train' is back on the tracks, climbing this week from number 45 to 32. Non Rod's last three singles have made the top 40, 'This Old Heart Of Mine' peaking at number 51 in November, 'My Heart Can't Tell You Now' reaching number 49 in May and 'Forever Young'

disappointingly fading after reaching number 57 in August 1988.

● **Eurythmics'** 'The King And Queen Of America' climbs to number 29 to become the third hit off their album 'We Too Are One'. It's a curious fact that sales of Dave and Annie's albums are holding up very well even though their singles are performing indifferently. 'We Too Are One' has sold over 450,000 copies, even though none of their last nine singles has reached the top 10, that honour being most recently reserved for 'Thorn In My Side' way back in 1986.

● **Record Mirror** reviewer and former **Housemartin Norman Cook's Beats International** project makes a fine first impression on the chart, with their remake of the **SOS Band's** 'Just Be Good To Me' (retitled 'Dub Be Good To Me') blazing in at number 15, only two notches lower than the SOS Band's peak. It's the second remake of a 1984 **Jimmy 'Jam' Harris/Terry Lewis** song to chart in three months, emulating **Tongue 'N' Cheek's** version of 'Encore' which peaked at number 41 in December, a little more than five years after **Cheryl Lynn's** recording of the same song peaked at number 68.

● **Cher** is gunning for success with 'Just Like Jesse James', which climbs a healthy seven notches to number 18. It advances a further eight places, she could be the first artist to register a top 10 hit in the Sixties, Seventies, Eighties and Nineties — but she'll have to be quick, as **Cliff Richard's** new single 'Stronger Than Before' is looking to stake the same claim for him. In fact, if it succeeds, Cliff will

uniquely have scored top 10 hits for FIVE decades in a row, as he had a handful of hits in the Fifties too.

"Likely to be big" quoted James Hamilton, when reviewing **E'AllorA's** import smash 'So What' in **Record Mirror** on 20 January. The following week it climbed as high as number 17 in our Club Chart, and is now circulating on a UK white label, with the artist credit amended to **Go'ss**. This gives a clue to the real identity of E-AllorA who is, in fact, that terminally unhip Irishman **Gilbert O'Sullivan!** With the ball now rolling so fast, expect 'So What' to give Gilbert his first hit since 1980.

● When it topped the chart a fortnight ago in a version by **Kylie Minogue**, 'Tears On My Pillow' — first recorded by **Little Anthony And The Imperials** — was 31 years old. It was

the oldest tune to reach number one 1987, when **Los Lobos** topped with 'Bamba', a traditional tune whose origin date back more than 200 years. And Gallup chart researcher Bob Macdona notes that, at two minutes 28 seconds Kylie's hit was the shortest to reach number one since **The Specials'** 'Too Much Too Young' (the lead track of the live EP) ruled the roost exactly a decade ago. It checked in at a concise two minutes and six seconds. Incidentally, some of my more respected colleagues, as well as radio deejays, have made the mistake of claiming that Kylie's 'Tears' is the same song as **Johnny Nash** had a number one hit with in 1975. Not so. Though they contain the lyric "Tears on my pillow, in my heart" they are otherwise unconnected. Johnny's hit was written Eric Smith, Kylie's by Al Bradford and Sylvester Lewis.
