CHARTS

THIS WEEK'S CHART ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

No change in the top two, but major upheaval throughout the rest of the singles chart this week, with nine records making their debut inside the Top 40 and many big movers. **Black Box** win the prize for the highest new entry at a canter, their second single 'I Don't Know Anybody Else' debuting at number five: Their first single 'Ride On Time' blocked

Technotronic's' 'Pump Up The Jam' from getting to Number One and 'I Don't Know Anybody Else' could well foil their latest 'Get Up (Before The Night Is Over), which logs its second week in runners-up position behind **Sinead O'Connor** this week, though it has closed the gap slightly.

'Get 1 lp' entered the chart at number a weeks ago, to become the highest debuting dance disc ever, replacing Bomb The Bass' 'Beat Dis' which entered at number five. Technotronic's lead singer Ya Kid K is also guest vocalist on fellow Belgian group $\operatorname{\textbf{Hi}}$ $\operatorname{\textbf{Tek}}$ 3's hit 'Spin That Wheel', which entered the chart at the same time as 'Get Up'. earning Ya Kid K the honour of becoming the first singer in the whole of chart history to sing lead on new entries by different acts in the same week (this excludes multi-artist discs like Band Aid) — it's right and fitting, therefore, :hat this precociously talented youngster. who was born Manuela Kamosi in Kinshasa, Zaire on 26 January 1972, should have a surname that translates literally rom the Kiyaka language as "the only one" or "the unique one".

The changes in the chart mean that **Phil Collins**, at number seven, is the only main to sing lead on a current top 10 lit, a record which will probably lever be beaten. Edging ahead of Phil at lumber six is **Sybil** with 'Walk On By', ast time out, Sybil reached number 19 vith a remake of 'Don't Make Me Over',

which had been **Dionne Warwick**'s first (and unsuccessful) single here in 1964. 'Walk On By' was also originally recorded by Dionne, whose version reached number nine over 25 years ago. Sybil's is now the most successful of the five versions of the song to chart, and 'Walk On By' is the only song thus far to chart in the '60s, '70s, '80s and '90s.

O Jimmy Jam and Terry Lewis wrote two songs in this week's Top 20, their brilliant 'Just Be Good To Me', originally recorded by the SOS Band, now standing at number three for Beats International under the title 'Dub Be Good To Me', while 'Come Back To Me', a song they wrote with and for Janet Jackson, climbs seven places to number 20. 'Come Back To Me' is the third hit off Janet's latest 'Rhythm Nation 1814' LP, and is now the biggest, topping both 'Miss You Much', which reached number 22 and 'Rhythm Nation', which peaked at number 23.

● "I been a drag racer on LSD, And I rode bare-assed on top o' the Sphinx, I even had a gorilla on the slopes of Kismet" ... yes, it could only be The Cramps, who finally cracked the top 40 last week with 'Bikini Girls With Machine Guns' a mere 14 years after they were formed. Unfortunately such lyrics tend to limit the amount of TV and radio exposure their songs can gain, and 'Bikini Girls' has thus been deprived of a wider audience and slips back to number 41 this week. Their latest album 'Stay Sick' includes another fun-filled potential hit in 'God Damn Rock 'n' Roll', wherein, we are informed that "Even before Van Gogh had art, Adam and Eve did it in the park". It's the sort of record that could put Van Gogh in the Top 10, something Del Amitri's 'Nothing Ever Happens', which also

namechecks the old Dutch master, narrowly failed to do, reaching number 11 last week, before dropping to number 14. Not that it would be Van Gogh's first taste of Top 10 success of course — that came as long ago as 1972 when **Don**McLean's tribute 'Vincent' reached Number One, earning it the curious and temporary honour of a daily play in Amsterdam's famous Van Gogh museum, where many of the artist's most famous works are displayed. The mention of Van Gogh in songs this year is probably coincidental, but very timely, as he died

exactly 100 years ago, though one of his

ears failed to complete his 37 year lifespan.

• 24 years after? (that's right,?') and the Mysterions' original recording '96 Tears' peaked at number 37, The Stranglers' remake debuts at numl 31. It's The Stranglers' first new single since 'All Day And All Of The Night' or released a little over two years ago, the a remix of their debut 1977 hit '(Get A) Grip (On Yourself)' made a brief c showing last year. The group has now charted for 14 years in a row, and its of 29 hits is exceeded by only six othegroups.
