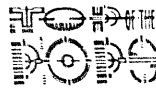

NEWS EXTRA PHIL WINS

Phil Collins and **Annie Lennox** took the big prizes at the Brit Awards broadcast on Monday night. Phil won top male singer while Annie won top female singer. Meanwhile, **Neneh Cherry** was named best international artist and **Lisa Stansfield** carried off a trophy for best British newcomer.

MANDELA CONCERT

A massive open air concert celebrating the release of Nelson Mandela is rumoured to be taking place at Wembley Stadium in the summer. Mandela himself, who was released this year after 27 years in prison, is thought likely to attend the show and we hear that **Madonna**, **Bruce Springsteen**, **Simple Minds** and **Peter Dinklage** will be among the stars performing. More details when we get them.

SINGLES MISTAKE

There's been a hiccup in the title of our Single Of The Week. The band is **Sweet Exorcist** and the title of the single is 'Testone' — not the other way round as we've printed it.

Second highest new entry to the album chart, at number 10, is not an album at all. It's a re-issue of **Iron Maiden's** first two singles — 'Running Free' and 'Sanctuary' — in twin pack 12-inch and CD formats only. With more than four tracks, and a playing time in excess of 20 minutes it is ineligible for the singles chart, and qualifies as an album by default. A further 18 singles by the group are to be released in similar pairings over the next nine weeks, and they too will presumably chart as honorary albums.

●**Lou Reed** first took a 'Walk On The Wild Side' in 1973, since which time many other recording artists have attempted to re-work his famous and rather rude

masterpiece, amongst them **Duffo**, **White Lies** and **Charm**, whose update climbed as high as number 109 just over a year ago. Two versions of the song are now competing for the chart honours, one by **Neneh Cherry's** pal **Jamie J Morgan**, the other by new group **Beat System**. Morgan had a couple of weeks' start, and is currently at number 36, while the Beat System's recording of the song gets off to a promising start this week, debuting at number 80.

●**Sybil's** album 'Walk On By' debuts at number 21, one place ahead of 'The Love Songs', a **Dionne Warwick** album which includes the original version of 'Walk On By'.

number 11, and is still therefore just short of winning the estimable **Ms Bono** the honour of becoming the first artist to score top 10 hits in the Sixties, Seventies, Eighties and Nineties. **Cliff Richard** is also in the running, as his latest single, 'Stronger Than That', debuts at number 19. Cher's album 'Heart Of Stone' — which includes both 'Jesse James' and her other recent smash 'If I Could Turn Back Time' — climbs to number seven, equalling her previous best album chart position, as achieved by her 1965 debut 'All I Really Want To Do'.

'Lily Was Here', the collaboration between **Eurythmics' Dave Stewart** (here billed more formally as David A Stewart) and Dutch saxophonist **Candy Dulfer**, debuts at number 42. Regular readers may recall that I wrote quite extensively about this track when it topped the Dutch charts in December. Incidentally, Eurythmics are trying to project a 'green' image, but I reckon they should be red — with embarrassment. Their album 'We Too Are One' is packaged in recycled paper, an ecologically sound, environmentally caring gesture that will undoubtedly have saved the lives of more than a few trees — but their current hit single 'The King And Queen Of America' is available in a deluxe CD edition which comes in a totally unnecessary wooden box!

Del Amitri's album 'Waking Hours' is a real sleeper. Released nearly eight months ago, it sold about 20,000 copies last year, but only really started to take off in the wake of their current hit single 'Nothing Ever Happens'. It climbed as high as number 84 five weeks ago, but was then deleted. Now re-launched it makes quite a splash, entering the chart at number six.

Lead O'Connor strengthens her steady vice-like grip on the top of the charts this week, as 'Nothing Compares 2 U' holds it for a fourth week, and tops half million sales. **Beats International's** 'Be Good To Me' moves up to number two, but its sales last week were less than half those of 'Nothing Compares 2 U'. Meanwhile,

Technotronic's 'Get Up ...' dips to number three, leaving the Belgian group in an unfortunate position of having each of their first two singles peak at number two. **Black Box** — whose 'Ride On Time' prevented Technotronic's 'Pump Up The Volume' from reaching pole position — move just one notch to number four with their latest offering 'I Don't Know Anybody Else', but can consider themselves unlucky not to have climbed there, as they are in an unusually strong position in which their own sales more than doubled.

Meanwhile, **Michael Bolton's** recent chart topper 'How Am I Supposed To Live Without You' soars 17 places to number five after trebling its sales. It's Bolton's first hit as a performer, and equals his highest placing as a writer, achieved exactly two years ago when

Reed took his song 'I Found Someone' to the heights. 'How Am I ...' was originally recorded by **Laura Branigan** some seven years ago. Bolton's disc leapfrogs **Depeche Mode's** 'Enjoy The Silence', but the boys from Basildon will still be beaming — as 'Enjoy The Silence' debuted at number 17 last week it was their highest new entry, and its current position number 33 is the group's best since 'People Are People' reached number four nearly six years ago. 'Her's' 'Just Like Jesse James' climbs to
