# CHARTS

THIS WEEK'S CHART  
ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

No change in the top three, but look out for **Jive Bunny & The Mastermixers**'s 'That Sounds Good To Me', which debuts at number four this week, and looks a good bet to stretch the rampant rabbit's run of consecutive number one hits to four. Several acts have had four number ones in a row (**The Beatles**, bless 'em, had 11 on the trot) but none has had more than three in a row at the very start of their hitmaking career, Jive Bunny currently sharing the record with **Gerry & The Pacemakers** and **Frankie Goes To Hollywood**.

● The latest Manchester band to break through in a big way are the **Inspiral Carpets**, whose 'This Is How It Feels' debuts at number 22 this week. This maintains the group's record of reaching a higher chart position with each release: 'Train Surfing' peaked at number 146, 'Joe' peaked at number 129, 'The Peel Sessions (EP)' peaked at number 126, 'Find Out Why' peaked at number 90 and 'Move' peaked at number 47 — and all within the last 12 months.

● **New Kids On The Block** launch their bid for a third consecutive number one, as 'I'll Be Loving You (Forever)' debuts at number 11 — two places lower than their last chart-topper 'Hangin' Tough'.

● **George**'s More Protein label claims its first top 40 hit as **E-Zee Posse**'s 'Everything Starts With An E' debuts at number 36. The record was first

released last August, when it peaked at number 69.

● 'Love Shack' vaults from number 14 to number six to become the **B-52's** biggest hit to date. They reached number 12 in 1987 with the reissue 'Rock Lobster/Planet Claire'.

● **Kate Bush**'s 'Love And Anger' climbs only one notch this week from its debut position of number 39 to number 38. It looks unlikely to go any higher, and will, therefore, become Kate's lowest charting hit since 'The Dreaming' reached number 48 in 1982.

● **Michael Bolton**'s debut hit 'How Am I Supposed To Live Without You' holds at number three again this week, while his album 'Soul Provider' debuts at number 8. The album was originally released last year, but failed to chart. It was withdrawn recently, before being re-launched last week, so its debut position reflects several weeks of demand. **WEA** appear to be working a similar trick on the B-52's album 'Cosmic Thing', which peaked at number 75, but is now very difficult to find.

● **Princess Ivori** makes her chart debut at number 69 this week with 'Wanted'. The record is based on **Honey Cone**'s 1971 single 'Want Ads', which failed to chart here, but was a number one hit in America.

**CHARTFILE USA EXTRA**  
**Janet Jackson**'s 'Escapade' remains at

number one for a third week, but seems likely to be toppled next time around by either Canadian newcomer **Alannah Myles**' 'Black Velvet' or 'Love Will Lead You Back', the sixth straight top 10 hit by **Taylor Dayne**. That's Taylor's entire recorded output.

Meanwhile, commiserations to **Richard Marx**, whose 'Too Late To Say Goodbye' — which he wrote with the **Tubes**' **Fee Waybill**, dips a notch from its peak of number 12. It's Richard's eighth single. His first seven all went top five, equalling the record established by **Air Supply** in 1982. The Aussie group blew it badly, their eighth and ninth singles both peaking at number 38.

**Madonna**, who had registered 16 consecutive top five hits (though, obviously, in view of the above, they were not her first 16 hits) before 'Oh Father' disappointingly peaked at number 20, is back on form with 'Keep It Together', which climbs five places to number 15. In so doing, it leapfrogs over **Michael Penn**'s debut hit 'No Myth', which inches up from number 17 to number 16. Michael is the elder brother of Maddy's estranged husband **Sean Penn**.

**Sinead O'Connor** registers her first

US hit with 'Nothing Compares 2 U' which debuts very promisingly at number 63. The record is still number one in Holland, Sweden, Norway, Switzerland and Germany, where it soared to number one last week only seven days after debuting at number six. But that's still compared to its progress in Australasia. **Down Under**, it debuted at number one prematurely ending the reign of **Aerosmith**'s 'Janie's Got A Gun' which had replaced the B-52's 'Love Shack' the top only a week earlier. Incidentally, Australia is another place where 'Oh Father' underachieved, becoming the Madonna single to peak short of the 50.

● **Lisa Stansfield** remains on course for an American number one hit, as 'Around The World' vaults from number 18 to number 12. Lisa's album 'Affection' does even better, soaring 100 places to number 39, only a week after Brit-based Pole **Basia**'s new album made an even steeper ascent from number 100 to number 34.

Lisa's album reportedly sold 45,000 copies on its first week on release in America, but, as always, their chart success such things much more slowly than

## TOWN AND COUNTRY REPRIEVED

## ANOTHER ACID CRACKDOWN

A bill cracking down on acid house events went before the House Of Commons last week. If it becomes law, organisers of illegal raves or house parties will be liable for fines of up to £20,000 and face six months in jail. Meanwhile, police clashed with ravers in Blackburn at the weekend making around a dozen arrests.
