CHARTS

THIS WEEK'S CHART ANALYSED BY ALAN JONES

- Beats International's 'Dub Be Good To Me' is the nation's number one single for the fourth week in a row, but the **B-52's**' 'Love Shack' very nearly unseated it. 'Dub' sold about 45,000 copies last week, a mere 250 more than 'Shack'. Next week, we'll undoubtedly have a new number one, but it may not be the B-52's, with Candy Flip, Erasure and New Kids On The **Block** also well-placed. There appears to be no way through for **Jive Bunny**'s latest single 'That Sounds Good To Me', which holds its debut position of number four this week, but with decreasing sales. And Figure are the least likely to succeed amon, ...he other runners. 'Blue Savannah' is their eighth Top 10 hit without reaching number one, a record for a duo.
- Joining the swelling ranks of records that fare better the second time around, **Del Amitri**'s 'Kiss This Thing Goodbye' returns to the chart at number 46 this week, seven months after peaking at number 59.
- Sinéad O'Connor becomes the first Irishwoman ever to have a number one album in Britain as 'I Do Not Want What I Haven't Got' debuts strongly at number one, after selling 100,000 copies last week.

Sinéad's single 'Nothing Compares 2 U', down to number 13 this week, has now sold over 650,000 copies in the UK. In America, it sprints from its debut position of number 63 to number 33. It is almost unproduced in recent years for a previously uncharted aritst to reach the Top 40 Stateside in just two weeks, so Sinéad must be fancied to repeat her chart-topping exploits there too. So far,

'Nothing Compares 2 U' has reached number one in 14 countries.

Sinéad's album's success means that Phil Collins' '... But Seriously' finally loses its grip on the top of the chart after a 16 week residency, interrupted only once when The Christians' album 'Colours' overtook it for a week in January. '... But Seriously' may, of course, rise again, but it's already the longestserving number one since 'Saturday Night Fever topped for 18 weeks in 1978. It passed the 14 week mark attained by Dire Straits' 'Brothers In Arms' a fortnight ago, but Straits' mainman, Mark Knopfler, very nearly earned instant revenge last week when his lastest project, The Notting Hillbillies' album 'Missing. Presumed Having A Good Time' debuted at number two, coming within an ace of dethroning '... But Seriously'.

Phil is overtaken not only by Sinéad O'Connor, but also by **David Bowie**, whose 'Changesbowie' debuts at number two, and **Nigel Kennedy**, whose six month old 'Vivaldi — The Four Seasons' album surges to number three to become the highest-charting classical album ever. The last version of 'The Four Seasons' to chart — by the **Academy of Ancient Music** conducted by **Christopher Hogwood** —

performed more modestly, reaching number 85 in 1985.

● 'Madly In Love' by **Bros** tumbles 16 places from what proved to be its peak position of number 14. Each of their previous eight singles reached the Top 10. Similarly, **Wet Wet** wet's sequence of seven straight Top 30 singles is broken by 'Hold Back The River' which recedes to number 37 after reaching number 31 a week ago.

wonderfully whimsical single 'Birdhouse In Your Soul' halves its position to number 17 this week. The record entered the Top 200 eight weeks ago, and has improved its standing every week since. Its progress so far: 170-132-107-87-74-47-34-17.

- Debuting at number 19, 'Manners & Physique' is **Adam Ant**'s highest-charting album since 'Friend Or Foe' reached number five in 1982.
- Lily Was Here' by **Dave Stewart** and **Candy Dulfer** climbs a further three notches to number seven. They are only the second Anglo-Dutch duo to reach the Top 10, emulating Edinburgh's **Scott Fitzgerald** and Amsterdam's **Yvonne Keeley**, who teamed up for

'If I Had Words', which climbed as hig number three on the chart in 1978.

CHARTFILE USA

Each of America's top three singles the week is performed by a female solois with **Alannah Myles** taking the honours ahead of **Taylor Dayne Janet Jackson**.

Dayne's 'Love Will Lead You Back' powerful ballad, surges from number to number two, and must be fancied reach the Top 10, the second best opening sequence of hits ever assemt by a female singer. It is bettered only **Whitney Houston**'s epoch-maki initial burst of 10 Top 10 hits in a rostarting with 'You Give Good Love' ir 1985, and ending with 'One Moment Time' three years later.
