'Vogue' by **Madonna** registers its third week at Number One, though with a greatly reduced majority over **Alannah Myles**' 'Black Velvet'. Maddy is still odds-on favourite to complete a fourth week on top, though she faces a strong challenge not only from Alannah, but also from **Soul II Soul**, whose 'A Dream's A Dream' was released on Monday. The record has already completed a mercurial rise through the ranks in the *Record Mirror* discochart. Debuting a fortnight ago at number 92, it soared to number eight last week and is now Number One.

● The **Prince**-penned 'The Sex Of It' climbs to number 35 this week, to become **Kid Creole And The Coconuts**' first Top 40 hit since 'There's Something Wrong In Paradise' in 1983.

● **Sinitta** bounces back into the Top 40 this week with her remake of **Vanity Fare**'s 1969 number 16 hit 'Hitchin' A Ride'.

It's her eighth Top 40 hit in all, and her third in a row with a cover version, following 'Love On A Mountain Top' (originally a hit for **Robert Knight**) and 'Right Back Where We Started From' (**Maxine Nightingale**), though her last single, 'Lay Me Down Easy', failed even to reach the Top 75.

CHARTFILE USE EXTRA

'U Can't Touch This' by **M.C. Hammer** makes a sensational debut on the US Hot 100 this week, entering the chart at number 27.

A crack off the young Oakland-born rapper's second album, 'Please Hammer Don't Hurt 'Em', it won the rare honour (particularly for a rap record) of becoming a massive airplay hit on Top 40 radio

stations across America whilst still an album track.

It is the highest debuting single by any act since **USA For Africa**'s 'We Are The World' debuted at number 21 a little over five years ago, on 23 March 1985.

Only two other records have made higher debuts in the last decade: **Michael Jackson**'s 'Thriller' and 'Say, Say, Say,' Jacko's duet with **Paul McCartney**.

In fact, the only singles ever to debut higher than 'U Can't Touch This' are as follows: NUMBER SIX: 'Let It Be' — **The Beatles** (21 March 1970) ● NUMBER 10: 'Hey Jude' — The Beatles (14 September 1968) and 'Get Back' — The Beatles (10 May 1969) ● NUMBER 12: 'Mrs. Brown You've Got A Lovely Daughter' — **Herman's Hermits** (17 April 1966) ● NUMBER 20: 'Something' The Beatles (18 October 1969), 'Imagine' — **John Lennon and the Plastic Ono Band** (23 October 1971) and 'Thriller' — Michael Jackson (11 February 1984) ● NUMBER 21: 'A Hard Day's Night' — The Beatles (18 July 1964) and 'We Are The World' — **USA For Africa** (23 March 1985) ● NUMBER 22: 'I Feel Fine' — The Beatles (5 December 1964) ● NUMBER 23: 'Lady Madonna' ● NUMBER 24: 'Surrender' — **Elvis Presley** (20 February 1961) and 'Valleri' — **The Monkees** (9 March 1968) ● NUMBER 25: 'Nowhere Man' — The Beatles (5 March 1966).

More impressively, it's not only the highest debuting rap record in the genre's history ('Rapper's Delight' by **Sugarhill Gang** was the very first rap record to make the Hot 100, towards the end of 1979) but also the highest-debating hit by an act new to the chart in the entire 32 year history of the Hot 100. (It was established in 1958, though **Billboard**

MADONNA BRITISH DATES ANNOUNCED

Madonna will be playing two shows at Wembley Stadium Friday July 20 and Saturday July 21 as part of her world tour and more dates at the Stadium are expected to be announced soon. It looks likely that she'll be playing at least one regional show, although as *Record Mirror* went to press, nothing had been confirmed. Tickets for Wembley priced £20 each and they are available from the box office and usual agents. There is also a Madonna information hotline on 0898 55444.

Madonna's new album, 'I'm Breathless', featuring songs from the soundtrack of her forthcoming film 'Dick Tracy', be out on May 21. Tracks include 'Vogue', 'I'm Going Bananas', and 'Sooner Or Later'.

published a shorter chart of varying length from 1940 onwards.)

Hammer's hit helps 'Please Hammer Don't Hurt 'Em' to climb to number six on the album chart this week. It has sold 1.2 million copies in just eight weeks, and seems certain to outsell his 1987 debut album 'Let's Get It Started', which has sold 1.6 million copies to date.

One old timer who has already declared his support for Hammer is **Little Richard**, who states: "I like him because his lyrics are clean; I think he's uplifting".

Meanwhile, one of the records to drop out of the chart this week to accommodate M.C. Hammer is fellow rapper **Young M.C.**'s 'Bust A Move', which spent 39 consecutive weeks on the chart — the longest run ever assembled by a rap record, and the longest unbroken

chart run of any single since 1982, by **Soft Cell**'s 'Tainted Love' rode the charts for 43 weeks in a row. Both records are a long way behind **Bill Crosby**'s 'White Christmas' which though it never managed more than a few weeks in the chart at a stretch, has a total of 19 times between 1942 and for a total of 72 weeks on the chart.

● **Sinéad O'Connor** complete notable chart double this week, as 'Not Want What I Haven't Got' made the top of the album chart, while her single 'Nothing Compares 2 U' continues its stint at Number One on the Hot 100. Sinéad's last album, 'The Lion And The Cobra', peaked at number 36.

In addition to America, Sinéad topped both the singles and albums lists in Germany, Sweden, Norway, Switzerland and Austria.
