AND INSPIRED BY THE FILM **DICK TRACY** **BREATHLESS**

Adamski's 'Killer' continues to trangle all opposition at the top of the chart, including **Kylie Minogue's** 'Better The Devil You Know', which leaps from number five to number two, but is unlikely to pose a threat, since it is, in reality, losing ground. Last week Adamski sold 50 per cent more records than Kylie — now he's selling twice as many.

'Venus' is the first song to become a hit in the Seventies, Eighties and Nineties — and one of only a handful of songs to become a hit for artists of three different nationalities.

Originally a hit for the Dutch group **Shocking Blue** in 1970, it was successfully revived by our very own **Bananarama** in 1986, and is now a hit for Italian group **Don Pablo's Animals**. Both the Bananarama and Shocking Blue versions of the song reached number eight. It was also covered by **Star Sound** as part of their first 'Stars On 45' medley, which reached number two in 1981.

En Vogue's 'Hold On' moves into the Top 10 this week. As previously reported, 'Hold On' has been a ridiculously successful title in America, being used for 12 different hits, but in Britain it has only previously been employed as the title of one chart record — a hit by **Street Band** (featuring **Paul Young**) in 1978, and even then it was listed as a hit only because it was the original A-side of 'Toast', which emerged as the disc's most requested side after picking up airplay.

Suddenly, however, there's a whole rash of chart contenders telling us to 'Hold On', with new singles of that title by **Wilson Phillips**, **Eric & The Good Good Feeling** and **The Telephone Operators**.

Incidentally, of the dozen US hits entitled 'Hold On', none were charted in the first 28 years of Billboard's listings — all 12 have been crammed into the last 22 years.

Fifteen-year-old **Emma's** Eurovision also-ran 'Give A Little Love Back To The World' climbs to number 33 this week, after climbing as high as number 39 a week ago. It's the first UK Eurovision entry to reach the Top 40 since 1984, when **Belle & The Devotions'** 'Love Games' reached number 11.

Both records were written by **Paul Curtis**, who also penned the British Eurovision entry for 1975, 'Let Me Be The One' by **The Shadows**.

Curtis also wrote **Manchester United Football Team's** 'We Will Stand Together' which will debut next week. It will be the club's fourth hit, equalling the football team record currently held by Liverpool and England.

United's FA Cup Final opponents **Crystal Palace's** single 'Glad All Over/Where Eagles Fly' climbs to number 50.

To use a phrase from her recent Number One hit 'Vogue', Madonna strikes a pose — but the shock is that the pose she chooses to strike is almost entirely

inspired by her role as Breathless Mahoney in the film 'Dick Tracy'.

'Vogue' is the only vaguely contemporary cut on 'I'm Breathless', sitting uneasily at the end of a gaggle of Thirties and Forties pastiches, most complete with big bang backings.

'I'm Breathless' is unlikely to take your breath away, comprising primarily of lame clichés — tap dancing, Betty Boop vocals and tinny sound are just three of the gimmicks employed to convey a period feeling.

The overall effect is more theatrical than cinematic, the songs sounding like rejects from an off-Broadway revival of a very minor stage show, even those written by sometime prime exponent of the genre, Stephen Sondheim, who offers the torchy 'What Can You Lose', sung by Madonna and classical singer (male) Mandy Patinkin, the sleazy, almost acceptable 'He's A Man' and the tortuous 'More'.

There's worse: 'I'm Going Bananas' is pseudo-tropical camp of the kind Kid Creole would reject on the grounds of quality control; on 'Hanky Panky' the title is repeatedly rhymed with "spanky spanky". Elsewhere in the same song, Madonna sings about "the back of your hand, somewhere on my behind".

Her obsession with her rump takes an even more astounding turn on 'Now I'm Following You', a duet with Warre Beatty in two parts. In the second, Madonna affects her best Mae West v and confides: "Dick ... that's an interest: name ... Dick, Dick, Dick, ... my bottom hurts just thinking about it."

As a parody of a musical, 'I'm Breathless' is charmless and unfunny, a follow-up to 'Like A Prayer' it is unacceptable, a disaster that will disappoint millions — and don't just take my word for it. In advance of its release next Monday (21st), WEA, who distribute the album, are making no secret of the fact that they are talking down record dealer expectations.

WEA marketing director David Evans says: "We don't see this album as a Madonna record in the same category 'Like A Virgin' or 'True Blue', both of which have sold five million copies in Europe.

"We are not raising expectations, we are simply presenting it for what it is."

"It is very much a concept record, but it is unlikely to be an instant smash unless there is a sudden Thirties revival within the next couple of weeks."
