● ENGLAND FOOTBALL TEAM AND NEW ORDER

Adamski's 'Killer' romps to an easy bird week at Number One, but will almost certainly be overwhelmed next week by the rampant **England/New Order** pairing 'World In Motion', which debuts at number 10.

It's the highest chart debut yet for either act, and brings to five the number of hits scored by the national soccer side — enough to put them at the very top of the league table of football's chart makers, one ahead of Liverpool. (I, like many others, expected **Manchester United's** latest disc to crack the Top 75 to give them their fourth, but the danger of this happening as abated, even though their more eagerly supported and ultimately defeated A Cup Final opponents **Crystal Palace** enjoyed a brief flirtation with the charts with their recent single.)

'World In Motion' is the 13th record to debut in the Top 10 already this year — which probably means the record of 30 established only last year will be broken. The other 12, in descending order of debut re: Number 2: 'Tears On My Pillow' — **Kylie Minogue**, Number 3: 'Get Up Before The Night Is Over' — **Technotronic**, Number 4: 'That Sounds Good To Me' — **Jive Bunny**, 'Vogue' — **Madonna**, Number 5: 'I Don't Know Nobody Else' — **Black Box**, 'Better The Devil You Know' — **Kylie Minogue**, Number 7: 'Brits 1990' — **Various**, Number 8: 'Elephant Stone' — **Stone Roses**, 'A Dreams A Dream' — **Soul II Soul**, 'Cover Girl' — **New Kids On The Block**, 'Hang On To Your Love' — **ason Donovan**.

The mercurial rise of England/New Order sadly means that **The Chimes** will not be ringing the bell at the chart summit.

Still, their version of 'I Still Haven't Found What I'm Looking For' has performed more than credibly. Remaining at number six this week, it has equaled the number six peak of the **U2** original, and breathed new life into the song — which is all you could really ask.

● The England Football Team was very nearly joined in the Top 75 this week by the **Scottish Rugby Team's** recording of 'Flower Of Scotland'. Had it charted it would have been the first hit ever by a rugby team.

● 'Venus' by **Don Pablo's Animals** scurries to number seven this week, eclipsing the number eight peak of both the original recording of the song by **Shocking Blue** and the more recent **Bananarama** remake, each of which peaked at number eight.

● 'Won't Talk About It' dips from its peak of number nine to number 11 this week for Norman Cook's **Beats International**.

Norman wrote the song with erstwhile Go! Discs labelmate **Billy Bragg**, who has now written two Top 10 hits for other acts, first coming up trumps in 1985 when his 'A New England' was a number seven hit in a cover version by **Kirsty MacColl**. In turn, the biggest hit Kirsty has yet written is 'They Don't Know', which got to number two for **Tracey Ullman**.

Billy Bragg's biggest self-penned, self-performed hit was 'Between The Wars,' which reached Number 15 in 1985, though of course he has had a Number One hit as a performer, his version of **The Beatles'** 'She's Leaving Home', on which he was accompanied by **Cara Tivey**, appearing on the other side of **Wet Wet Wet's**

chart topping 'With A Little Help From My Friends'.

● 'Loving You' by **Massivo featuring Tracy** climbs to number 56 It's a remake of **Minnie Riperton's** number two hit from 15 years ago, on which Tracy (Ackerman) proves that she can match the late Ms Riperton's vocal dexterity and four-and-a-half octave (36 note) range.

Tracy was formerly with **Shakatak** and **Mirage** and also fronted **This Year's Blonde**, who scored a minor hit in 1981 with 'Platinum Pop', a medley of **Blondie** songs.

● **Eurythmics'** latest single, 'Angel', turns tail and heads back down the chart after peaking at number 23.

In 1983/84, Dave and Annie had a run of six straight Top 10 hits. By contrast, none of their last 10 singles has climbed higher than number 16. Their last Top 10 hit was 'Thorn In My Side' in 1986.

● With 'Reputation' steadily climbing the chart, **Dusty Springfield** is the first British female to have hits in the Sixties, Seventies, Eighties and Nineties.

Dusty's forthcoming album includes a

remake of the **Steve & Eydie** du 'Want To Stay Here', which dropped out of the chart the very week that Dusty scored her maiden solo hit with, 'I Only Want Be With You', in November 1963.

CHARTFILE USA EXTRA

● **Paula Abdul's** debut album, 'Forever Your Girl', logged a massive 64 weeks in the US Top 10, finally dipping from number eight to number 12 last week. This week it falls even more precipitously to number 18.

Why so? Simply because it is not available in a remix version under the 'Shut Up And Dance'. Qualifying for chart in its own right, the album debuted at number 52 last week, and now soars to number 13. In the UK, chart regulations allow 'Shut Up And Dance' and 'Forever Your Girl' to be combined for its purposes as happened with **Jai Jackson's** 'Control' and 'Control — Remixes', though her label may alternate to keep them separate, as did MCA with **Bobby Brown's** 'Don't Be Cruel' and 'Dance! . . . Ya Know It'.

'Forever Your Girl' has sold very nearly seven million copies in America, and this week will be its 100th in the chart.
