album 'Between The Lines'.

Against expectations, Soul II Soul stay at Number One with a very comfortable margin over Jason. Sales of 'Between The Lines' must have shocked and disappointed record dealers. They ordered over 300,000 copies of Jason's album, enabling his record company PWL to claim a platinum disc, which was awarded to him on his 22nd birthday last week. But by close of business on Saturday, four out of every five copies were still sitting on record shop shelves — 'Between The Lines' sold fewer than 60,000 copies last week.

'Between The Lines' may never rival the 1,500,000 plus sales of Jason's debut album '10 Good Reasons', but it will undoubtedly sell far more copies than it has to date, and may yet rise to Number One as hit singles reveal themselves.

'Sacrifice/Healing Hands' to AIDS charities. It's a shocking indictment of the music industry that this is only the second AIDS-aid record to be released to date. The first was **Dionne and Friends** 'That's What Friends Are For', a number 16 hit in 1985. Dionne's 'Friends' were **Gladys Knight, Stevie Wonder** — and Elton.

Elton's current hit is not the only record on the chart to make a better showing the second time around. **Talk Talk**'s 'It's My Life' climbs to number 13 this week, having originally peaked at number 46 in 1984, and **NWA**'s 'Express Yourself', though now in remission, reached number 26 last week, after first reaching number 50 last September.

● **Soul II Soul**'s head-to-head clash with **Madonna** in the battle for Number One billing in last week's album chart was resolved in their favour, but not until Maddy gave them a good run for their money. Her 'I'm Breathless' album — panned first and exclusively here before being the subject of equally vitriolic comment elsewhere — nevertheless sold over 100,000 copies on its first week in the shops, more than any other album that has not reached Number One at any other time — except in the period immediately before and after Christmas, when sales levels generally rise steeply.

Had it reached Number One, 'I'm Breathless' would have been Madonna's fourth chart topper — a record for a female soloist. Instead, she remains in a tie with **Kate Bush** and **Barbra Streisand** who have likewise had three Number Ones.

After seeing off Madonna, Soul II Soul defeat another challenge this week, this time from the new **Jason Donovan**

There's a group in the chart that was formed in 1872. Since then nearly 1,000 members have passed through its ranks. It didn't make its first record until 1970, and is only recorded sporadically since. Its line-up continues to change at regular intervals, and there are no survivors from a 1970 disc on the group's current hit. That's a pedigree that could only apply to the **England Football Team**, who scored their second Number One this week as 'World In Motion ...', their likely pairing with **New Order**, thanks to the top of the chart, crowning **Adamski**'s 'Killer', 'World In Motion ...' is New Order's first Number One, but England's second, lowering their aforementioned 1970 single 'Kick It Up'.

The England tally of five hit records is as good as a football team, and the Number One billing of 'World In Motion ...' represents a major improvement in their fortunes since their last record, the **Rock Aitken Waterman** written and produced 'All The Way', which peaked at number 64 in 1988.

Elton John returns to the Top 30 for the first time in two years as 'Sacrifice/Healing Hands' smashes into the chart as a week's highest new entry at number 45.

It's a richly deserved success for Elton, crowning the two previously under-achieving singles off his latest album 'Sleeping With The Past'. 'Healing Hands' originally peaked at number 45 in September last year. 'Sacrifice' fared even worse reaching only number 55 a couple of months later. Both records are gone on to become worldwide smashes, particularly 'Sacrifice'. In a typically generous gesture, Elton is donating all his royalties from sales of
