● **England/New Order** continue at Number One, but they could be under severe pressure next week, notably from **New Kids On The Block's** 'Step By Step', which debuts at number two. **Elton John's** 'Sacrifice/Healing Hands', which soars from number 26 to number five and even **Luciano Pavarotti's** 'Nessun Dorma', which sensationally debuts at number 21.

'Step By Step' is the highest debuting single yet for New Kids On The Block, easily beating the number nine debut of Hangin' Tough in January and the number eight debut of 'I'll Be Loving You Forever' in March. They are the first act to have three singles debut in the Top 10 his year. Last year **Madonna** also had three singles debut in the Top 10, while **Jason Donovan** went one better with four.

'Sacrifice/Healing Hands' is Elton John's highest charting single since January 1988, when his live rendition of 'Candle In The Wind' also peaked at number five.

Pavarotti's recording of 'Nessun Dorma' is the official BBC 'Grandstand' World Cup theme, and in debuting at number 21 it was not only torpedoed a rival recording of the **Puccini** composition by fellow opera star **Placido Domingo** Placido's version, which was first off the mark, was number 79 last week and is now posted at number 63, but also comfortably surpasses the peak chart position of the recordings selected by the BBC to introduce their coverage of the last two World Cups. In 1986, **Heads** 'Aztec String' peaked at number 45, and in 1982 the **Royal Philharmonic Orchestra's** 'BBC World Cup Grandstand' peaked at number 61.

Apart from the England/New Order, Pavarotti and Domingo discs several others associated with the current events in Italy are scattered around the charts: **Pop Will Eat Itself's** 'Touched By The Hand Of Ciccolina' (number 28), **The Scotland World Cup Squad's** 'Say It With Pride' (number 45), **The Pogues & The Dubliners's** 'Jack's Heroes' (number 64), **The Republic Of Ireland Football Squad's** 'Put 'Em Under Pressure' (number 94), **Rod Argent and Peter Van Hooke's** 'Tutti Al Mondo' (the ITV World Cup Theme) (number 113), **The Giorgio Moroder Project's** 'To Be Number One' (number 121) and **Goal II Goal's** 'Oh No, Not Football' (number 162).

If England's games this week have gone well, they will probably remain at Number One on Sunday. Curiously, of the trio bidding to replace them, New Kids On The Block have the least chance of success. 'Step By Step' was otherwise unavailable last week, but is on the Kids' new album that was released on Monday, a fact which will dull its sales — and, in any case, the Kids find it hard to pick up sales from casual record buyers, the bulk of their sales being made to committed fans. Elton and Luciano's current hits, however, are both enjoying a more organic growth, and appeal to a very wide cross section of record buyers.

● **Betty Boo's** 'Doin' The Do' climbs to number seven, equalling the chart peak of 'Hey DJ, I Can't Dance To That Music You're Playing', the **Beatmasters'** track that gave her her first break. 'Doin' The Do' has already improved on the chart peak of **Reparata & The**

Delrons' 'Captain Of Your Ship', which reached number 13 in 1968. The melody over which Betty raps is taken from this, hence the composer credit on 'Doin' The Do' for 'Captain's' writer **Kenny Young**.

● For the second time in a matter of weeks, **Brown And Sharpe** are in the Top 40. The difference is that while the latest duo of these names to make an impression was Capital Radio DJ's **Pat (Sharpe)** and **Mick (Brown)**, the new Top 40 success 'The Masterplan' is the work of **Diana Brown** and **Barrie K Sharpe**.

Meanwhile, just missing out on the Top 40 is **Belinda Carlisle**, whose latest single, 'Vision Of You', heads south after a fortnight at number 41. Each of Belinda's last two singles spent a single week on the Top 40. 'La Luna' reached number 38, and 'Runaway Horses' got to number 40.

● **Roxette's** 'It Must Have Been Love' surges from number 21 to number six, beating the number seven peak of their previous biggest hit, 1989's 'The Look'.

'It Must Have Been Love' is America's new Number One — Roxette's third in a little over a year. Only acts from America and Britain have had more Number Ones, though **Paul Anka** (Canada), **Helen Reddy** (Australia) and **Milli Vanilli** (France/Germany) have also topped the chart on three occasions.

● **Little Caesar** is a name previously more associated with pizza — it's America's second biggest chain, and has an outlet mouthwateringly close to Chartfile's Thameside hovel — than with charts, but in consecutive weeks different acts of that name have made their British and American chart debuts — both with revivals of former hits.

Last week, Britain's Little Caesar entered the UK listings with a dance-orientated and mighty fine remake of **The Waterboys'** 1985 hit 'The Whole Of The Moon'. This week, American rock band Little Caesar — **Ron Young, Apache, Louren Molinare, Fidel Paniagua** and **Tom Morris** — hit the US Hot 100 with their update of

Aretha Franklin's 1968 hit 'Chai Fools'. They'll have to do pretty well to improve on Aretha's success however sold over a million copies of the disc, which reached number two.

● Mixed fortunes for the Dutch **Liebrand** family. **Rita's** 'Freestyle Megamix' of **Bobby Brown** tracks climbs 17 places to number 22, while brother **Ben's** 'Pul(s)tar', his debut so far after numerous successful remixes of other artists' recordings, dips from its debut position of number 68 to number 72.
