# CHARTFILE

Almost 14 years after his only previous British Number One, **Elton John** is back on top with 'Sacrifice/Healing Hands'. Elton last reached Number One in July 1976, duetting with **Kiki Dee** on 'Don't Go Breaking My Heart'. As a solo act, Elton had placed over 40 hits on the chart before his current single, but never managed to top the number two peak of 'Rocket Man' in 1972. No other act has had so many hits before first reaching Number One.

'Sacrifice' and 'Healing Hands' are both taken from Elton's album 'Sleeping With The Past', which peaked at number six last September. The album re-entered the chart a week at number 64, and now climbs to number 54. His next single, also from the album, will be his current US hit 'Club At The End Of The Street', flipped by a previously unreleased live version of the **John Lennon/Plastic Ono Band** hit 'Give Peace A Chance'.

Elton's current hit is likely to have another couple of weeks at Number One, though opera singer **Luciano Pavarotti's** 'Nessun Dorma' — up from number 22 to number three — has a chance of overtaking. It is, though, only a slim chance, as the publicity 'Nessun Dorma' has generated as BBC TV's World Cup Theme is working more in favour of 'The Essential Pavarotti', a compilation of the Italian tenor's best known recordings that soars from number eight to Number One on this week's album chart. It's the first ever classical/opera album to reach Number One — and the first by an Italian act.

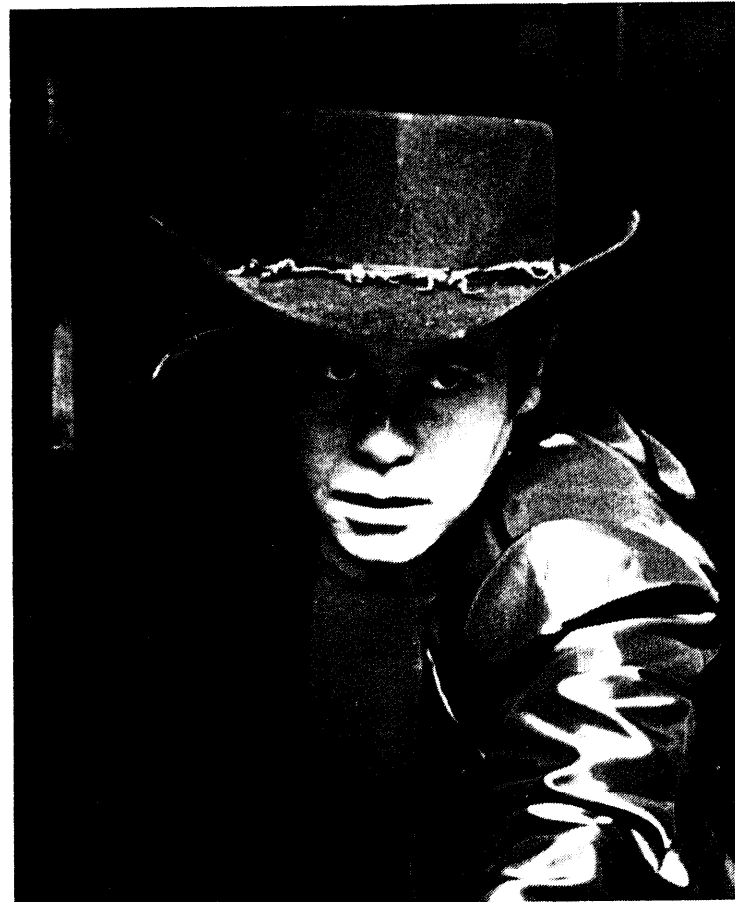
The vocal single version of 'Nessun Dorma' — it means 'None Shall Sleep' — by **Placido Domingo** climbs from number 63 to number 59, while two other versions of the track can be found

on both of the top two albums of the compilation chart: 'The Classic Experience II' — Number One — features a recording by **Jose Carreras and the Philharmonic Orchestra of Strasbourg**, while 'A Night At The Opera' includes a vintage (1959) performance by **Giuseppe De Stefano**.

'Nessun Dorma' was written by Italian composer **Giacomo Puccini**. It's the most widely known melody in his opera 'Turandot', which was unfinished at the time of his death at the age of 66 in 1924.

● Proceeds from the sales of 'Sacrifice/Healing Hands' will be shared among four AIDS charities. 1990 is the seventh year in a row that at least one charity record has topped the chart since **Band Aid's** 'Do They Know It's Christmas' set the ball rolling in 1984. The others: 'We Are The World' — **USA For Africa** (1985), 'You'll Never Walk Alone' — **The Crowd** (1985), 'Dancing In The Street' — **David Bowie and Mick Jagger** (1985), 'Living Doll' — **Cliff Richard and The Young Ones** (1986), 'Let It Be' — **Ferry Aid** (1987), 'With A Little Help From My Friends' — **Wet Wet Wet/She's Leaving Home** — **Billy Bragg and Cara Tivey** (1988), 'Ferry Across The Mersey' — **The Christians, Holly Johnson, Paul McCartney and Gerry Marsden** (1989) and 'Do They Know It's Christmas' — **Band Aid II** (1989).

The Ferry Aid, Christians/Johnson/McCartney/Marsden and Band Aid II discs were all produced by **Mike Stock, Matt Aitken and Pete Waterman**. Pops most philanthropic producers, they have also helmed hit charity records by **Pat And Mick**

(Let's All Chant', 'I Haven't Stopped Dancin' Yet' and 'Use It Up And Wear It Out') and the team of **Bananarama** and **LaNeeNeeNooNoo** ('Help'). Their eighth charity hit is this week's highest new entry on the chart at number 19 — 'You've Got A Friend' by **Big Fun And Sonia**. Like the Wet Wet Wet/Billy Bragg and Cara Tivey single listed above, it was re-recorded to raise funds for the Childline charity.

● **Iron Maiden's Bruce Dickinson** registers his second solo hit this week as his cover of David Bowie's 'All The Young Dudes' debuts at number 32. It was originally a number three hit for **Mott The Hoople** in 1972. Meanwhile, 'The Rise And Fall Of Ziggy Stardust And The

Spiders From Mars', by the old dude himself, re-enters the chart at number 31. Considered by many to be the classiest Bowie album, it reached number five when first released here in 1972. Pavarotti will contend that the newly released 'Ziggy' album to be a new compilation just a re-issue of the original, since it includes not only the entire original, but also five other tracks.

● **Craig McLachlan** is the fourth member of the 'Neighbours' cast to a Top 20 hit. Former colleagues **Janet Donovan** and **Kylie Minogue** both had Number One hits too numerous to mention, while **Stefan Dennis** reached number 20 a year ago with 'It Make You Feel Good'.
