CHARTFILE

● The top of the singles and albums charts tell remarkably similar stories this week. On the singles chart, **Elton John** enjoys a third week at Number One, though **Luciano Pavarotti** is now in close pursuit — while on the album chart Elton's 'Sleeping With The Past' is now fully available again and soars from number 54 to number two, being deprived of top billing only by ... 'The Essential Pavarotti'.

'Sleeping With The Past' has surpassed the number six peak it scaled last September, and is now Elton's highest charted album since 'Breaking Hearts' peaked at number two in 1984. Elton topped the chart four times in the Seventies, most recently in 1974, with 'Elton John's Greatest Hits'.

● 5-4-3-2-1 — how high will it go? Based on **Barry Gray**'s original 'Thunderbirds' theme, 'Thunderbirds Are Go' by **F.A.B.** featuring **M.C. Parker** makes a sensational chart debut this week at number 12. Gray's original version of the cult Sixties show's theme very belatedly charted in 1981, peaking at number 61.

● Previously hidden away on the flipside of her earlier hit 'Come Back To Me', **Janet Jackson**'s 'Alright' is finally a single in its own right. Sporting new mixes by **C.J. Mackintosh** and **Dave Dorrell**, it fully justifies the decision to release it by exploding onto the chart at number 29 this week. It's the fifth single thus far lifted from Janet's album 'Rhythm Nation 1814' — and each of the others has reached a higher position in the chart than ... predecessors.

The introductory 'Miss You Much' reached number 25, 'Rhythm Nation' got to number 23, 'Come Back To Me' peaked at number 20 and 'Escapade'

petered out at number 17.

Janet also took five Top 40 hits off her last album 'Control' ('What Have You Done For Me Lately', 'Nasty', 'When I Think Of You', 'Let's Wait Awhile' and 'Pleasure Principle'). The title track and 'Funny How Time Flies (When You're Having Fun)' also charted, though outside the Top 40, to bring the total of Top 75 hits off 'Control' to seven. **Madonna** is the only other woman to have two albums yield five Top 40 hits apiece — and Janet's first 12 hits have come off just two albums — an unprecedented feat.

● **Maureen**'s version of 'Thinking Of You' climbs to number 11 this week, equalling the position reached by **Sister Sledge**'s original version of the song in 1984. It's Maureen's second Top 10 single. The first was 'I Say A Little Prayer', on which she was guest vocalist with **Bomb The Bass**.

It reached number 10 in December 1988. Maureen launched her solo career with 'Don't Hold Back', which peaked at number 93 in April.

● 'The Great Song Of Indifference' is being treated with anything but indifference, and climbs this week to number 15 to become **Bob Geldof**'s highest charting solo single, beating the number 25 peak of his first solo hit 'This Is The World Calling' in 1986.

In fact, disregarding Band Aid, 'The Great Song Of Indifference' is Geldof's biggest hit since **The Boomtown Rats**' 'Banana Republic' reached number three in 1980.

● **The Neville Brothers**' version of cheerful Canadian **Leonard Cohen**'s 'Bird On A Wire' enters the Top 75 at number 72 this week.

The song was also released as a single by **Jennifer Warnes** in 1987, her version peaking at number 128. It was Jennifer's follow-up to her recording of another Cohen song 'First We Take Manhattan', which reached number 75 and was the last Cohen song to chart. Both songs were included on Warnes' album 'Famous Blue Raincoats', which comprised exclusively of the songs of Leonard Cohen.

The Neville Brothers' version of 'Bird On A Wire' from the forthcoming film of the same title, was produced by **Eurythmics**' **Dave Stewart**, who also donated the previously unreleased instrumental track 'Lumiere' as the B-side of the current **Traveling Wilburys** hit 'Nobody's Child'.

● Three of the top four singles in America this week are by artists discovered by **Maurice Starr**.

Top producer Maurice, who wrote and produced **New Kids On The Block**'s 'Step By Step', which holds at Number One, before assembling **NKOTB**, he was responsible for putting together **New Edition**, whence came both the number four act **Bell Biv DeVoe** and **Bobby Brown**, who

contributes a guest rap to the number three single 'She Ain't Worth It' by **Glenn Medeiros**.

Another former member of New Edition, **Johnny Gill**, is at number with his hit 'Rub You The Right Way' while **Bell Biv DeVoe**'s new single 'Dee Dee' climbs to number 78. Finally, 'The Right Combination', **New Kids' Donnie Wahlberg**'s duet with Japanese singer **Seiko Matsuda** climbs to number

'The Right Combination' is Seiko's debut, but she is hardly a "new girl" as I heard her described by one of R. I.'s supposedly more informed deejays. She is, in fact, the most successful singer ever back home in Japan, where she had an incredible 16 Number One and 25 Number One singles.

'The Right Combination' is taken from her album 'Seiko', on which she is featured by **Gloria Estefan**, **Michael Bolton**, **Jellybean** and **Giorgio Moroder**, to name but a few.

● Janet Jackson's 'Come Back To Me' climbs a startling 49 places on the US 100, from number 93 to number 44. That's the biggest leap made by any since 28 April 1979, when **Donna Summer**'s 'Hot Stuff' soared from number 79 to number 29.

ADAMSKI SINGLE

Adamski's next single, due out in early August, is likely to be a double A-side featuring 'Future' and 'Heaven'. We're told that 'Heaven' was inspired by the cult horror film 'Erasurhead'. Adamski's now working on his debut album and it looks like he'll be announcing some dates very soon.

GOOD MORNING MADONNA

Madonna will be featured in a series of five exclusive interviews on TV breakfast time show 'Good Morning Britain' starting on Monday July 9 7.50 am. Filmed in Washington, Madonna will be talking about her new film 'Dick Tracy', and there will also be clips of her in concert. Remember to set your alarm clock.

808 STATE PARTY

808 State will be hosting a special end of tour party at the Manchester International II on July 7. MC Tunes will be there as well and tickets available from the box office and usual agents.
