Phil Collins' latest album '... But Seriously' was recently certified platinum or the SEVENTH time, and has now sold over 2,100,000 copies. That's the highest sale ever for an album on Virgin, beating the 1,800,000 mark set by his own 'No Jacket Required', and recently equalled by **Mike Oldfield's** 'Tubular Bells'.

Only three albums have sold more copies than '... But Seriously' in the last decade — **Dire Straits'** 'Brothers In Arms', **Michael Jackson's** 'Thriller' and 'Bad'.

'... But Seriously' is currently number 10 in the chart. It has spent 33 weeks — its entire chart career — in the Top 10. The album to register more consecutive weeks in the Top 10 was 'Brothers In Arms', which lodged there for 60 weeks in 1985/86. More recently, **Madonna's** 'True Blue' spent 32 weeks in the Top 10 in 1987 before exiting from the upper echelon in dramatic fashion, suddenly dipping to number 22. Later that same year, **U2's** 'The Joshua Tree' planted itself in the Top 10 for 28 weeks, and last year **Kylie Minogue's** 'Kylie' put together a run of 29 consecutive Top 10 appearances.

With three Top 20 singles already lifted from '... But Seriously' ('Another Day In Paradise', 'I Wish It Would Rain Down' and 'Something Happened On The Way To Heaven'), the most obvious next single would be 'Do You Remember?', already a number four hit for Phil in America. Instead, his record company has opted to release 'That's Just The Way It Is', which is scheduled to come out next Monday (16).

The first million sales of '... But Seriously' were concentrated into the final five weeks of 1989. It reached the million sales mark more quickly than any album before, but because of the lateness of its

release it was only the third best selling album of 1989.

As far as 1990 is concerned, it looks unbeatable. It has already sold another million copies, and has sold as many copies as the year's number two and three albums added together.

BROWN SNR RAPE CHARGE

It's interesting to note that though they have no singles in the Top 20, **New Kids On The Block** have FOUR singles amongst the year's Top 40: 'Hangin' Tough' at number 23, 'Cover Girl' at number 37, 'I'll Be Loving You Forever' at number 38 and 'Step By Step' at number 40.

'Hangin' Tough' was, of course, a number one record, but is ranked six places below **Dave Stewart** and **Candy Dulfer's** 'Lily Was Here', which sold considerably more copies even though it peaked at number six. It just proves that a record's highest chart position tells only half the story at best.

Note too that only three acts in the Top 20 singles for the year-to-date do have albums in the Top 20, these being **Sinéad O'Connor**, **Luciano Pavarotti** and **UB40**. The degree of "crossover" between the two charts is usually much greater.

I've actually been on holiday for two past fortnights, so Chartfile has been written way ahead of the fact. Any further developments I appear to have ignored will be fully covered on my return.
