● **JANET JACKSON:** "My plastic surgeon said I have to hold my new ears while the glue sets"

Janet Jackson becomes only the second act to twice take as many as six hits off an album this week, as 'Black Cat' creeps into the singles chart. The other act to achieve this impressive feat is none other than Janet's wild and wacky brother Michael.

Janet lifted seven hits off her 1986 album 'Control' and has now taken half a dozen off 'Rhythm Nation 1814'. Before 'Black Cat', there was 'Miss You Much', which peaked at number 25, 'Rhythm Nation' (number 23), 'Come Back To Me' (number 20), 'Escapade' (number 17) and 'Alright' (number 20). Released a year ago next week, 'Rhythm Nation 1814' has been curiously unable to capitalise on Janet's string of hit singles, selling only around 200,000 to date.

The Steve Miller Band's 1973 single 'The Joker' moves into the Top 10 this week, to become Miller's second biggest hit, behind the 1982 number two smash 'Abracadabra'.

As I mentioned a couple of weeks ago, it's the seventh Top 20 hit to chart after being used in a TV advertisement for Levi 501 jeans. But don't get the idea that the mutually beneficial relationship between jeans and discs always pays huge dividends; **B.B. King's** 'Ain't Nobody Home' and **Bad Company's** 'Can't Get Enough' have both peaked at number 88 in the last year after being selected to feature as soundtracks to adverts for 501s. **The Ronettes'** 'Be My Baby' was also released, but for some reason wasn't re-released and therefore (check this logic!) failed to chart.

The **New Model Army** register their 10th hit from as many releases as 'Get Me Out' enters the chart this week.

I'm fairly confident that it won't surpass the number 28 peak of their first and thus far biggest hit, 1989's 'No Rest', leaving the trio in the position of having had more hits than any other act that has never reached the Top 20.

● Already firmly established at the top of the club chart, **Deee-Lite's** 'Groove Is In The Heart' climbs into the top five of the pop chart this week.

Housing one of the few Japanese-born artists ever to have a UK hit (**Jungle DJ Towa Towa**) and one of the incalculable hundreds of New Yorkers to do (**The Lady Miss Kier Kirby**, to give her full and pretentious handle), Deee-Lite's personnel also includes **Super DJ Dmitry**, a keyboards player and exiled Moscovite, who thus become the first Soviet-born chart star.

● The **Cocteau Twins** return to the singles chart for the first time in nearly four years with 'Iceblink Luck', which has already topped the peak position of four of their five previous hits, the exception being their introductory hit 'Pearly Dewdrops' Drops'.

● Its majority is slashed, raising hopes that next week it may be overhauled by something a little more palatable, but **Bombalurina's** 'Itsy Bitsy Teeny Weeny Yellow Polka Dot Bikini' is Number One for the third week in a row, having now sold over a quarter of a million copies.

● **Jon Bon Jovi's** first solo single 'Blaze Of Glory' moves to the top of America's Hot 100 this week. As leader of Bon Jovi, Jon has had three previous Number Ones,

scoring with 'You Give Love A Bad Name' in 1986, 'Livin' On A Prayer' in 1987 and 'Bad Medicine' in 1988.

● **MC Hammer's** adaption of the **Chi-Lites'** 'Have You Seen Her' inches up to number six in America this week, while **Paul Young's** recording of the same group's 'Oh Girl' advances from number 25 to number 19.

Raiding the Chi-Lites' archives was clearly a good move for both — MC Hammer's only previous hit 'U Can't Touch This' peaked at number eight, and Paul Young hasn't had a hit this big since 1985, when 'I'm Gonna Tear Your Playhouse Down' peaked at number 13.

'Have You Seen Her' and 'Oh Girl' were consecutive hits for the Chi-Lites, the former reaching number three in December 1971, and the latter going all the way to Number One in May 1972.

● 25 years after it originally peaked at number four, **The Righteous Brothers'** 'Unchained Melody' is shaping

up as a serious contender for Number One. Featured in the movie 'Ghost', it entered the chart a fortnight ago at number 78, and sprinted to number 51 week ago. Now it's posted at number 7. That's serious progress in America, and almost exactly mirrors its 1965 moves, when it went 72-56-38.

If 'Unchained Melody' does reach the summit, it won't be its first time at Number One. Written by **Hy Zaret** and **Alex North** for the film 'Unchained' in 1954, it topped the chart for **Les Baxter and His Orchestra and Chorus** the following year.

Though 36, 'Unchained Melody' is not the oldest song on the chart — that honour belongs to 'Georgia On My Mind' written by **Stuart Gorrell** and **Hoagy Carmichael** in 1930, and a hit for **Michael Bolton**.
