● **DEEE-LITE:** "You told us we'd be playing classy joints so what's with this tinsel and mushy peas dive?"

takes a massive 22 place leap this week, and seems likely to provide the next real challenge to The Steve Miller Band's supremacy at the top of the chart.

It's Maria's first solo disc since leaving **Lone Justice**, and appears on the soundtrack album to the **Tom Cruise/Robert Duvall/Randy Quaid** film 'Days Of Thunder', alongside new recordings by **Tina Turner**, **Elton John**, **Guns n' Roses**, **Cher**, **David Coverdale** and several others.

If it reaches Number One, it will be the second chart-topping ballad to start out in a Tom Cruise film. The other? **Berlin's** 'Take My Breath Away', a 1986 chart champ from 'Top Gun'. Coincidentally, 'Take My Breath Away' is re-issued next week, to tie in with the TV premiere of 'Top Gun'.

● Rapper **Monie Love** returns to the chart this week with her version of 'It's A Shame', the debut 1970 hit for the

Detroit Spinners. Coincidentally, the group, which last appeared in the chart decade ago, should return itself next week with the 'Boilerhouse Remix' of their 1979 smash 'Ghetto Child'.

● Contrary to correspondent **Tim Mickleburgh's** views, as expressed in last week's Letters (*Record Mirror* September 15), **Craig McLachlan** is the first ever act to score consecutive Top 20 hits with songs named after girls — at least by my definition. I was including or excluding songs whose titles comprised exclusively of girls names, not those that included them, thus 'Oh Julie' renders **Shaky's** claim to the record, as promoted by Mr Mickleburgh, invalid.

If I had been taking account of songs that only contained girls names, I would certainly have pointed out **Harry Belafonte's** feat of having consecutive hits with 'Mary's Boy Child', 'Little Bernadette' and 'Son Of Mary' in 1957/!

er the controversy surrounding its ascent to Number One last week, **The Steve Miller Band's** single 'The Joker' establishes a commanding lead, moving 26 per cent ahead of runners-up **Deee-Lite's** 'Groove Is In The Heart'. It's interesting to note that apart from the row over whether or not it should have been Britain's only Number One last week, there has been no controversy about 'The Joker' at all, this despite the fact that it includes the line "I'm a midnight lover". I searched several dictionaries before I found the word listed at all, but finally found it defined as "to puff on a (marijuana) cigarette". Radio 1, which is normally very realistic about such things, is playing 'The Joker' regularly, apparently without any qualms — probably because no-one there understands its lyrics any more than they understand the sexual connotations of **Lou Reed's** 'Walk On The Wild Side' in 1973. On the 'The Joker', Steve Miller — who is, incidentally, convicted for possession of marijuana on a late Sixties visit to Britain — also sings about being "the impatus" or "pompatus" of love. I can't find this in any dictionary. Any bright ideas?

'Cult Of Snap' by **Snap** debuts at number 21, far outranking the near-annual cover of the song by Italian group **I Power**, which peaked at number 73 three weeks ago. 'Cult Of Snap' and 'I Can't Stand It' — a new entry at number 28 for **Twenty 4 Hour's** featuring **Captainolly Wood** — are the first of this year's continental holiday hits to filter through to the chart, in the grand tradition of 'Y Viva Espana', 'Tarzan Boy', and others too horrific to mention.

● The year's second biggest-selling single, 'Sacrifice/Healing Hands' by **Elton John**, dips out of the chart this week, after a 15 week residency. 'Goodbye Yellow Brick Road' thus remains his longest-running hit, having spent 16 weeks in the listings (then only 50 positions deep) in 1973/74.

● Britain is in the middle of its biggest dance boom ever, but nobody appears to have told **Iron Maiden**, or **AC/DC**, or their followers. The two hard rocking groups have the week's highest new entries, with Maiden's 'Holy Smoke' — their first single of the year — debuts at number three, while AC/DC's 'Thunderstruck' — their first single since April 1988 — debuting at number 16.

Maiden's debut is the highest of their 10 year, 21 hit chart career, beating the number four debut of 1988's 'Can I Play With Madness'. The single went on to reach number three to become the group's biggest hit. It was also the first of what is now five consecutive Top 10 hits by the group — a record for a metal act.

In stark contrast, though 'Thunderstruck' is AC/DC's 19th hit, they have yet to reach the Top 10, coming closest in 1988 when 'Heatseeker' reached number 12.

If 'Thunderstruck' fails to capitalise on its great start, AC/DC will once again draw level with **The Clash** to share the record for most hits without ever reaching the Top 10, a record The Clash made their own earlier in the year when 'Return To Brixton' fizzled out at number 57.

Meanwhile, **Loose Ends** — who had looked set for their first Top 10 hit when their 11th chart entry 'Don't Be A Fool' leapt from number 21 to number 13 last week — slip to number 17.
