# CHARTFILE

An all-American top three this week, with **Maria McKee's** 'Show Me Heaven' taking over from **Steve Miller Band's** 'The Joker' at Number One.

McKee's hit is the third Number One in the past five years to mention heaven in its title, following **Wham's** 1986 topper 'The Edge Of Heaven' and **Belinda Carlisle's** 'Heaven Is A Place On Earth' from 1988. The only noun to prove a more regular visitor to the chart summit in the same period is 'heart'. McKee penned 'Show Me Heaven' with **Jay Rifkin** and **Eric Rackin** — and she also wrote one of the Number One heart songs — **Feargal Sharkey's** 'A Good Heart', which was Number One in November 1985.

'Show Me Heaven' is the first hit to be lifted from the 'Days Of Thunder' soundtrack album. The second, 'The Last Note Of Freedom' by **David Coverdale**, was released on Monday.

Recent weeks have seen fewer new entries to the singles chart than normal, but that all changes this week, with no fewer than 11 discs making their introductory chart appearance in the Top 40. A few months ago that would have been a record, but on 12 May there were 13 newcomers to the Top 40 — two of which graduated from the 41-75 region of the chart and 11 first-timers.

If you thought **Deee-Lite** were pretty cosmopolitan (their three members hail from the USA, Japan and the USSR), what about **Twenty 4 Seven**? The quartet from four different countries — the USA, Germany, Holland and Italy. Their debut hit 'I Can't Stand It' has already been a top five hit in 10 countries, selling over a million copies. It soars from

number 28 to number 11 in the UK this week.

In the early part of last week, **The Cure's** new single 'Never Enough' was selling so well it looked likely to become the first record by the veteran group to debut inside the Top 10 — but by the time **Bruno Brookes** made his final countdown of the chart on Sunday (**Mark Goodier** takes over next week), it was ranked at number 15. It's still a good effort, bearing in mind that The Cure's highest debut is only number 12 — by 'Lullaby' last year.

Meanwhile, a record that strengthened as the week went on and very nearly pipped The Cure for the honour of being the week's highest new entry was 'Blue Velvet' by **Bobby Vinton**. It didn't even get into the shops until Tuesday, and was placed 55th in the first of Gallup's midweek charts (available only to the record industry, so don't ask) but by the end of the week it was number 16 — and is clearly a future contender for Number One.

It was **Vinton's** first chart appearance since 1964. In the whole of chart history, only two artists have had a longer gap between hits — **Eartha Kitt** and **Richie Valens**, both of whom returned after absences of more than 28 years. Like Vinton, Valens' return to the chart came via a re-issue. Kitt's feat of making the chart with a new recording is arguably a much greater achievement.

'Blue Velvet' was originally released without charting in 1963, and is one of three newcomers to this week's Top 40 that failed first time around. The others: **The Chimes's** 'Heaven', a remix of a song which peaked at number 66 in

December, and **Hit Tek 3/Ya Kid K's** 'Spin That Wheel', which struggled to number 69 in February.

The reformed duo of **Daryl Hall** and **John Oates** return to the chart this week for the first time in five years with 'So Close'. It's their 15th hit. Only two American duos have had more — the **Everly Brothers** and **The Carpenters**.

**Neneh Cherry** and her half-sister **Titiyo** return to the chart this week with 'I've Got You Under My Skin' and 'Flowers' respectively. There's a fourth pair of full sisters to add to the list of three (Chartfile passim) who've each had solo hits — **Stella** and **Dolly Parton**.

Britain's **Maxi Priest**, **George Michael** and **Phil Collins** are all lining

up to have a crack at Number One in Billboard US Hot 100, but they'll have wait at least another seven days, 'cause this week's champs are **Nelson**, with '(Can't Live Without Your) Love And Affection'. **Matthew** and **Gunnar Nelson**, and the act they replace at Number One (**Wilson Phillips**) are the daughters of members of **The Beach Boys** and **The Mamas & Papas**. It's the first time in US chart history that the offspring of one Number One act have toppled the offspring of another at Number One.

Incidentally, the outgoing Number One by Wilson Phillips ('Release Me') is the second in as many releases, emulating 'Hold On'. They're only the fourth act top the chart with its first two hits in last decade — following **Men At Work**, **Tiffany** and **Rick Astley**.
