Maria McKee's 'Show Me Heaven' is Britain's Number One single for the fourth week in a row, with **Status Quo**'s 'The Anniversary Waltz' moving up to number two, ahead of **Bobby Vinton**'s 'Blue Velvet', which dips a notch to number three

Vinton's hit equalled the number two peak of **Alannah Myles**' single 'Black Velvet'. As Gallup chart researcher Bob Macdonald points out, the only other title available to artists mentioning velvet and beginning with 'Bl...' is 'Blonde Velvet'.

 While the first hit from the 'Days Of Thunder' soundtrack ('Show Me Heaven') continues at Number One, the second —

**D** 'd **Coverdale**'s 'The Last Note Of Frecuom' — has peaked short of the Top 75, and the third, 'You Gotta Love Someone' by **Elton John** debuts this week at number 46.

Coverdale's single is flipped by **Hans Zimmer**'s 'Car Building', which is also the B-side of 'Show Me Heaven'.

● Tina Turner's 'Be Tender With Me Baby' climbs to number 29 this week — not bad for the fifth hit off an album that has sold over 1,250,000 copies, as Tina's 'Foreign Affair' has.

In the chart now for over a year, 'Foreign Affair' also contains 'The Best' (a number five hit), 'I Don't Wanna Lose You' (number eight), 'Steamy Windows' (number 13) and 'Look Me In The Heart' (number 29).


Meanwhile, 'Cold Hearted', the sixth hit from **Paula Abdul**'s album 'Forever Your Girl' dips out of the chart after pg at number 46. Only one other female — Paula's sometime choreographic client Janet Jackson — has pulled more hits from an album.

'Cold Hearted' followed the number three hit 'Straight Up', 'Forever Your Girl' (number 24), 'Knocked Out' (number 21), '(It's Just) The Way You Love Me' (number 74) and 'Opposites Attract' (number two).

● The highest new entry of the week on both sides of the Atlantic is 'I'm Your Baby Tonight' by **Whitney Houston**. Her first single in two years debuts at number 16 in Britain, and number 42 in America.

It is the latest in a long line of hit singles penned and produced by LA Reid and Babyface, who were also responsible for Johnny Gill's new single 'Fairweather Friend', which debuts this week at number 88 Stateside, and for both new entries in this week's US Top 10 -- 'Giving You The Benefit' by Pebbles and 'Can't Stop' by After 7 — these being the 17th and 18th US Top 10 hits helmed by LA and Babyface since August 1987, a phenomenal record of success unequalled by any other current team. ● The oldest duettists on the current chart are **Iggy Pop** and **Kate**

Pierson from the B-52's. The 43-year-old Iggy and 42-year-old Kate have a hit with 'Candy' — but it's a fairly safe bet to assume that Rod Stewart (45) and 50-year-old Tina Turner will also chart with their upcoming remake of the old Marvin Gaye/Tammi Terrell hit 'It Takes Two'.

- Bad luck for Scottish group the **Shamen**, whose dance hit 'Make It Mine' debuted at number 42 on the singles chart four weeks ago, and looked destined to climb into the all-important Top 40. It never did, remaining at number 42 for three weeks, before slipping back to number 46 last week. A recovery would seem to be out of the question as it dips to number 62 this week.
- Depeche Mode's 'World In My Fyes' dips from its peak of number 17 to number 21 this week.

It was not therefore, one of thei hits. Nevertheless, 1990 is the first which the group has claimed three hits since 1984. Their grand tally of Top 75 hits has been accumulated under ten years.

- 'Dance Of The Mad' is **Pop Wiltself**'s seventh hit, but they have reach the Top 20. It debuted last v number 32, threatening to overtaknumber 28 peak of their last single biggest hit to date) 'Touched By Thof Cicciolina', but it falls back to not 38 this week.
- Taylor Dayne's proud run o consecutive US Top 10 hits has cor an end. Taylor's latest single 'Heart Stone' peaked at number 12. It was eighth release and all the previo seven reached the Top 10.
