Unchained Melody is once again way ahead of the field at the top of the singles chart, with no currently available records looking to be sufficiently popular to challenge its supremacy for at least a fortnight.

'Unchained Melody' has now sold well over half a million copies, and has come from nowhere to number three in the 1990 rankings in less than a month. cliff Richard's 'From A Distance ... The Event' and Paul McCartney's 'Tripping The Live Fantastic'. The albums neatly represent the extremes of live discs, whatever your personal tastes, it has to be admitted that Collins' set features an impeccable vocal performance from the old buffer with no studio overdubs in evidence. McCartney's 'Tripping' is equally undeniably live, with Macca's vocals ranging from barely adequate to excruciating. Cliff, God bless him, is a good Christian, and for him to release what purports to be a live album when it is clear that a good deal of it was overdubbed in the studio is a little bit naughty.

That Collins and McCartney have fallen short of the chart summit with live follow-ups to Number One studio albums is not too surprising — live albums almost always perform less well chartwise than studio albums — though it is something of a shock to see **Whitney Houston**'s latest (and studio recorded) album 'I'm Your Baby Tonight' debut as low as number six, when her last album 'Whitney' not only debuted at Number One — it stayed there for six weeks.

● Elton John's 'The Very Best Of . . .' continues at Number One on the album chart, while his 'Sleeping With The Past' falls to number 45. They will be joined in the chart shortly by another EJ album, an expanded version of 'The Very Best Of . . .' entitled 'To Be Continued' — a "67 song, five hour journey through Elton's greatest hits and rarities," according to record company blurb.

A four record boxed set, it comes with a 44 page booklet, photos and an in-depth interview with Elton. It also includes newly recorded material, the original demo of 'Your Song' and other previously unreleased tracks.

Incidentally, I boobed last week when I suggested that Elton was the first artist to have two Number One albums in a year since 1983. **Gloria Estefan** turned the trick only last year. Sorry, Glo.

● The La's single 'There She Goes' advances strongly again this week, climbing from number 20 to number 13. When it was first issued at the beginning of 1989, it peaked at number 59.

● Jason Donovan's 'I'm Doing Fine' dips seven places from its peak of number 22 to number 29. It's the first single by Donovan to fall short of the Top 20.

Incidentally, Pete Waterman, who

wro. · and produced the single with **Mike Stock** and **Matt Aitken** responded to the suggestion that **SA** were unrepresented in the Top 75 fc week recently by suggesting that this not the case, and that they had a cou of hits in the chart on which their nar did not appear.
