While Britain shivers **Vanilla Ice** keeps his cool and his Number One title with 'Ice Ice Baby, though its lead is melting away, and the odds on it registering a fourth week on top are slim, with **Madonna**'s 'Justify My Love' and **The Righteous Brothers**' 'You've Lost That Lovin' Feeling/Ebb Tide' now the prime contenders, not only for next week, but also for the Christmas Number One.

'You've Lost That Lovin' Feeling' debuts at number 12 this week, and The Righteous Brothers are still in the top 10 with 'Unchained Melody', which dips to number five this week. PolyGram report that the latter title has sold 75,000 copies on compact disc and well over 140,000 on cas a single — both figures being unprecedented.

Bill Medley, who partnered **Bobby Hatfield** in The Righteous Brothers, has another new entry in the chart this week with another oldie, duetting with **Jennifer Warnes** on '(I've Had) The Time Of My Life', from the movie 'Dirty Dancing'. It debuts at number 56 this week, ahead of the film's TV première.

- New Kids On The Block become the first group ever to register eight top 10 hits in a year as 'This One's For The Children' climbs to number nine. They're the first act of any description to have eight top 10 hits in a year since 1985, when Madonna went one better, placing an octet of hits in the top five.
- If I told you that Margaret Thatcher vc Labour, that England's cricket team wc ... win back the Ashes in Australia this winter or that **Pat & Mick's** 'Use It Up And Wear It Out' would be the highest new entry on the US Hot 100 this week, you would undoubtedly call me a liar —

and you'd be right, except that the impossible has happened, and Pat & Mick's single has entered the US chart as the top newcomer at number 86 this week. Funny old world, isn't it?

● Shakin' Stevens' new single 'The Best Christmas Of Them All' made a bright enough start to its chart career this week, debuting at number 34. Shaky will be hoping it will bring him his third Christmas-related top 10 hit, following the number two success of his 1982 'Shakin' Stevens EP' (lead track: 'Blue Christmas') and his 1985 tree-topper 'Merry Christmas Everyone'.

The only act to have three seasonal top 10 hits thus far is **Cliff Richard**, with 'Little Town' (1982), 'Mistletoe And Wine' (1988) and the current 'Saviour's Day'.

The act with most hits referring to the forthcoming festivities is **Elvis Presley**, who scored with 'Santa Bring My Baby Back To Me', 'Blue Christmas', 'If Every Day Was Like Christmas', 'It Won't Seem Like Christmas Without You' and 'Santa Claus Is Back In Town' — but only the first of these climbed as high as the top 10.

'The Best Christmas Of Them All', incidentally, is Shakin' Stevens' fifth hit of 1990, equalling his best-ever annual tally established in 1982. But, whereas all his hits that year peaked at number 11 or higher, his peak position this year is a modest number 18.

● Julee Cruise's 'Falling', from director David Lynch's cult TV favourite 'Twin Peaks' dips to number 12 this week. But there's still a Lynch connection in the top 10, as Chris Isaak's single 'Wicked Game' climbs to number 10. The song is featured in Lynch's latest movie 'Wild At Heart'.

Unedited from the album, the seven-inch version of 'Freedom' is the longest single on the chart, running for six and a half minutes. The last hit with a longer playing time was 'Theme From "Vietnam", a minor hit for the French Orchestre De Chambre in 1988, which is better known as Pachelbel's 'Canon' (or 'Kanon'), a classical piece which was also the inspiration behind 'All Together Now', the current smash from The Farm, which races from number 12 to number four this week to become their biggest hit to date, while posing no pretentions to the chart crown. Older readers will also remember First Class 1974 hit 'Beach Baby', which uses the same chord sequence as 'Canon' and, therefore, 'All Together Now'.
