### ● Meat Loaf scores hat-trick ● Bryan Adams storms into singles top three

#### CHART FOCUS

Three out of four ain't bad: The remarkable Meat Loaf success story reaches a new peak this week, with his album *Bat Out Of Hell II - Back Into Hell* at number one in Britain and America, while his single *I'd Do Anything For Love (But I Won't Do That)* is number one here, and number two Stateside, with every chance of reaching pole position next week.

Meat is the first artist to have the number one single and album simultaneously in Britain since *Right Said Fred*, whose finest hour came nearly 18 months ago when *Deeply Dippy* was the number one single and *Up the Number One* album. In its short (seven week) chart career, *Back Into Hell* has had four separate runs at the top of the album chart, a very rare feat, although it was most recently achieved by REM's *Automatic For The People*. *Back Into Hell* has already sold around 400,000 copies.

Meanwhile the album that started it all, *Bat Out Of Hell*, moves up four places to number 33 this week. It's not charted in the US Top 200, but that's simply because catalogue albums are ineligible for the chart there. If it was eligible, however, it would be in the Top 50 there too. Last week, it sold 20,000 copies in America, and was the second biggest selling oldie, just behind the Beatles' 1967-1970 and just ahead of the same group's 1962-1966. (Incidentally, although the 1967-



She's had more charted albums than any other female, but a number one has proved elusive in Diana Ross' solo career. Though it isn't quite a solo album (four of its 20 tracks feature the Supremes and one pairs her with Lionel Richie), Diana's latest career retrospective *One Woman - The Ultimate Collection* comes tantalisingly close this week, debuting at number two behind Meat Loaf's *Back Into Hell*. One of surprisingly few hits albums in the Top 20 as we approach the year's climax, it actually contains three previously unreleased newly recorded songs, all produced by Nick Martinelli.

1970 album outsold the 1962-1966 album almost everywhere when initially released, the US is the only territory in which 1967-1970 has

the upper hand since the albums' recent CD release.)

Back on the UK singles chart, the relentless flood of singles that debut in the Top 10 continues, with this week's highest placed newcomer being Bryan Adams' *Please Forgive Me*, which debuts at number three. That's easily the best start of Adams' career, beating the number eight debut of *(Everything I Do) I Do It For You*. It's a good week for Adams, who also co-wrote the latest hit by Tina Turner, who debuts at number 16 with *Why Must We Wait Until Tonight*. It's eight years ago this week since Tina and Bryan's duet *It's Only Love* made its chart debut on the way to a number 29 peak.

Another old-timer making a stylish return is Phil Collins. Phil has had 47 hits (26 as a member of Genesis) but the number seven debut of *Both Sides Of The Story* is a personal best for him, topping the number nine debut of *A Groovy Kind Of Love* in 1968, and equalling the top Genesis debut, achieved when their live rendition of *Invisible Touch* entered the chart at number seven nearly a year ago.

Finally, in a week when no fewer than 26 singles enter the Top 75, let's make a special mention of the record that slipped into anchor position - the newly written but authentically Sixties sounding *Heart And Soul*, a duet between those old rivals Cilla Black and Dusty Springfield - and old is the operative word here, since Cilla (50) and Dusty (54) are the most elderly female duo ever to chart.
