● **D:Ream** gives Magnet first No 1 in 20 years ● **Diana Ross** back at album peak

CHART FOCUS

While its founders are still looking for major success with their current label M&G, the Magnet record label registers its first number one single in 20 years, as **D:Ream's** remixed/reissued *Things Can Only Get Better* takes over at the summit of the chart.

Magnet was a fully independent label when it had its only previous number one hit via Alvin Stardust's *Jealous Mind* in 1974. It was subsequently sold to Warner Music by founders Michael Levy and Tony Russell in 1987.

Warners initially discontinued the label, having transferred major assets Chris Rea's recordings to an in-house label, but has subsequently revived it, a move that culminated in D:Ream's current success.

It's interesting to note that while *Top Of The Pops* continues to have at best patchy success - **Ce Ce Peniston's** single *I'm In The Mood* dips despite exposure last week, for example - other programmes can have a dramatic sales effect on records.

There were two good examples of such beneficial television exposure this week.

Country singer **Garth Brooks** appeared on Des O'Connor's chat show, turning a mid-week mid-chart position for *The Red Strokes* into an impressive number 22 debut, and finally kick-starting the country singer's UK career, two years after



The week's highest new entry, perhaps surprisingly, is **Tori Amos' Cornflake Girl**, the first single from her upcoming second album *Under The Pink*. **Cornflake Girl** debuts at number seven, easily beating the peak positions attained by the four singles lifted from **Tori's** debut album *Little Earthquakes*. Vocal support for **Tori** on *Cornflake Girl* comes from veteran soul scorchers **Merry Clayton**, who most memorably contributed vocals to the Rolling Stones' favourite *Gimme Shelter*, and has added her voice to more than a thousand other tracks as a session singer.

his *Shameless* single peaked at number 71.

Also, an Oprah Winfrey programme dedicated to **Diana**

Ross returns Ms Ross to the top of the album chart with *One Woman - The Ultimate Collection*, yet again leaving the unfortunate **Dina Carroll's** *So Close* stranded at number two.

More whimsically, of all the thousands of records to have passed through the Top 75, the one with the shortest title makes its chart debut this week. **Loni Clark** made her chart debut last year with *Rushing*, and now returns at number 28 with the short but concise title *U*.

Twenty eight weeks into its chart career, **Bjork's** debut album climbs to number four, its highest placing yet.

Also reaching dizzy new heights this week is **Eternal's** album *Always & Forever* which climbs to number 11, while **Meat Loaf's** *Bat Out Of Hell* album is placed 14th, tantalisingly close to the number nine position which is the highest it has reached in a chart career of nearly 16 years.

Finally, let's tip our hat to the ILR stations. Not known for adventurous programming, they rarely add records by unknowns, but at number 35 of this week's Network Chart is *Come In Out Of The Rain*, the debut single by **Wendy Moten**.

The young singer from Memphis is signed to EMI, and her single isn't out until 24 January (the Network Chart is based on sales and airplay, and it's not necessary for a record to be released for it to chart), but it has been picked up by most of the independent local radio stations ahead of **Radio One FM**, hence its impressive debut. **Alan Jones**
