● **D:Ream hold back Braxton, again** ● **Tori Amos storms albums chart**

CHART FOCUS

D:Ream enjoy a fourth week at the top of the singles chart with *Things Can Only Get Better*, and their achievement is all the more remarkable since they are one of the few successful UK acts in the singles chart this week.

After last week's worst-ever showing by local talent at the top of the singles chart - one wholly British and one partly British act in the top 14 - foreign acts have an even more impressive stranglehold on the chart this week, limiting British acts to the same tally of success in the top 17. The album chart is slightly less troubled territory, though there are no British acts in the top six even there. The arrival next Monday of the latest Brits awards could hardly come at a better time for British talent it celebrates.

Meanwhile **Toni Braxton** - one of an unusually large contingent of five first-time chartmakers in the Top 10, all American - is putting the squeeze on **D:Ream** even though it's three weeks since her solitary *Top Of The Pops* plug. **Toni** or **Enigma** are likely to mount an irresistible challenge next week, though **Celine Dion** and **Aretha Franklin** are also in with a shout.

Meanwhile, **Elastica**, who have emerged to replace **Suede** as the band most fancied to succeed by the inkiest, make their chart debut at number 20 with *Line Up*. Ireland's equally favoured **Cranberries** see their reissued *Linger* finally crack it, as it debuts at number 16, following



Only two years after it was a number 15 hit for its writers, **Clivillés & Cole**, **A Deeper Love** returns to the chart in a hurry, debuting at number five for veteran **Aretha Franklin**. Produced by **C&C** in a style not far removed from their original, it has become one of the biggest hits of an astounding 38-year recording career for the 51-year-old Franklin. From the movie, *Sister Act II*, and featured on her upcoming *Greatest Hits 1980-1994* album, her recording of **A Deeper Love** is already her second biggest solo success in the UK, being shaded only by 1968's number four hit, *I Say A Little Prayer*.

its American success, which saw it "linger" three weeks at number 12 before jumping to number eight this week. The band's debut album,

Everybody Else Is Doing It, So Why Can't We? has sold a million copies in America in the last seven months.

After some head-scratching midweeks, the UK singles chart makes an extremely smooth transition from **Gallup** to **Millward Brown**, with no unexpected about-turns or inexplicable surges registered, while the album chart is also very stable, except, that is for the expected high-flying arrival of the latest albums from developing US talents **Tori Amos** and **Garth Brooks**.

Tori and **Garth** are both coming off the biggest hit singles of their careers, and their albums give the industry a much needed boost this week as they debut at one and two respectively.

Tori's *Under The Pink* hits number one a year after her debut album, *Little Earthquakes*, peaked at number 14, while **Brooks' In Piel** claims the number two slot, easily beating the number 41 peak scaled by his previous UK entrant, *Ropin' The Wind*, exactly two years ago.

Gallup was never able to persuade sufficient specialist reggae and bhangra shops to join its panel. While it remains to be seen whether or not **Millward Brown** are more successful in this respect, it should be noted that Asian music label **Multitone** registers its greatest success this week as **Tu Hai Mera Mera Sanam** - a bhangra version of **Whitney Houston's** chart-topper *I Will Always Love You* - charts at number 116 for **Mangal Singh** and **Amar**.
