CHART FOCUS

Had, as widely anticipated, Manchester United Football Squad lost their chart crown to Wet Wet Wet this week, there would have been five new and different number one singles in as many weeks for the first time since 1954.

In fact, Manchester United held on well, adding a singles chart double top to their Premiership and FA Cup double clinched two weeks ago at Wembley.

However, Wet Wet Wet - who themselves have footballing connections as the sponsors of the Glasgow team Clydebank - are hot favourites to take their chart title next week, when the full impact of their song's use in the blockbuster Four Wedding And A Funeral should be felt.

While all last week's five highest new entries make upwards progress - a rare feat - this week's top newcomer is No Good (Start To Dance) by The Prodigy.

The XL-signed act, masterminded by keyboards player Liam Howlett, are the only consistently successful rave group, with seven consecutive top 15 hits to their credit.

Among the week's other newcomers is Tori Amos, who becomes the first artist this year to register three Top 40 hits, although the debut position of Past The Mission - at number 35 - indicates that it will struggle to rival her January hit, Cornflake Girl (which



Erasure register their fourth consecutive number one album this week as I Say I Say I Say debuts in pole position, outselling its rivals by a margin of nearly three to one. Erasure have topped the chart with The Innocents (in 1988), Wild! (1989) and Chorus (1991). They are signed to the Mute label which had a number one with Depeche Mode's Songs Of Love & Devotion last April. The only other existing label to have scored five number one albums is PWL, which reached the figure last June with 2 Unlimited's No Limits, and will be looking to better Mute when the Dutch duo's Real Things is released next month.

reached number four), or Pretty Good Year (number seven) in March.

If at first you don't succeed, try

again. Adhering to that maxim has payed dividends for Tony Di Bart, Clubhouse and Alex Party to name but three acts.

But there is another school of thought which clearly believes that if at first you do succeed, then try again regardless.

How else is possible to explain the growing proliferation of records that have made the Top 40 only to get reissued shortly afterwards?

In this latter category are Red Hot Chili Peppers' Under The Bridge, Deacon Blue's Dignity and Salt-N-Peppas's Shoop. The latter single was released as recently as last October, reaching 29. London Records clearly believed that it wasn't as big as it should have been. And the label is rewarded this week with an 18 placing.

While The Time Frequency score their fourth Top 40 hit with Such A Phantasy again relying on sales almost entirely from their native Scotland, PWL nearly manages to fire its dance act Sound Crowd Orchestra into the Top 75 on sales from Ulster alone. The group's Sixth Season is a hot hit in the Republic of Ireland, where it reached number eight, raising its profile in the North.

Finally, it is also worthwhile noting that for the first time there are two Irish acts in the albums chart.

The Cranberries' Everybody Else Is Doing It, So Why Can't We climbs two places to four, while Chris de Burgh debuts at five with This Way Up. **Alan Jones**
