

● REM roar to their third number one ● Madonna and Elton trail Whigfield

CHART FOCUS

Whigfield's Saturday Night continues to do great business and far outpaces all other singles. It sold a further 140,000 copies last week to bring its total to 680,000 sales in less than a month. In each of the four weeks it has been number one, it has sold more copies than its long-running predecessor Love Is All Around did in any of its 15 weeks at the summit.

While Whigfield's single looks set to become the highest selling debut since Jennifer Rush's The Power Of Love in 1985, this week's two highest entries come from long established acts - Madonna registers hit number 33 with Secret, while Elton John's tally rises to 65 with Circle Of Life.

For both artists, the singles represent a resurgence: Elton hasn't had a bigger solo hit since The One in 1992. Ditto Madonna, for whom Secret is the biggest hit since Erotica. It augers well for Maddy's upcoming album Bedtime Stories, which is due in three weeks.

The (almost) title track of that album, Bedtime Story, was written by Nellee Hooper and Bjork, the Icelandic icon whose Best Mixes From The Album Debut was the 10th biggest selling album last week but is not listed on the chart as its low price makes it ineligible.

One album which is in the Top 10 this week is The Commitments' movie soundtrack, which re-entered the chart as part of the Woolworth's catalogue campaign a few weeks ago.



As our front page story reveals, REM's Monster makes quite a splash this week. It outsells the number two album by Cyndi Lauper by a margin of very nearly eight to one and sold as many copies last week as all of the rest of the Top 10 added together. It's the third consecutive REM album to debut at number one since 1991. The two others were monsters too - 1991's Out Of Time is the 12th biggest seller of the 1990s, while the next year's Automatic For The People ranks 10th. Both have sold about 1.5m copies and the latter album debuted at number one exactly two years ago this week.

The second boost of on ITV screening eight days ago pushes it further from 26 to nine this week. It has spent 110 week in the chart since it was first released in 1991, selling around 900,000 copies.

Fellow Celts The Cranberries also make a major move up the album chart for the second week in a row, advancing from number 49 to number 26 with Everybody Else Is Doing It, So Why Can't We?, which is clearly benefitting from the success of their single Zombie even though the single is actually lifted from their new album, No Need To Argue, which is out today (Monday).

MFP's mid-priced imprint Premier makes its second incursion to the chart via Joe Longthorne's Live At The Royal Albert Hall, which debuts at 57. It's the entertainer's fifth chart album and duplicates the success that Premier had with Shirley Bassey Sings Andrew Lloyd Webber earlier this year.

Chrysalis suffers its second disappointment in three weeks as Scots rock band The Almighty achieve only a number 15 debut with their first album for the label, Crank despite scoring their biggest hit single, Wrench, a fortnight ago and that their last album, Powertrippin' - on Polydor - reached five. The disappointment comes as Ensign's Sinead O'Connor album Universal Mother slides from 19 to 28, despite deserved critical acclaim and a Top Of The Pops appearance.

Notes: Madonna's 35th consecutive top 10 single (including re-issues) makes her the UK's most successful top 10 artist. Secret is taken from her forthcoming ninth album, Bedtime Stories, co-produced with Maddy by Dallas Austin, former member of After 7 and producer of Boyz II Men's debut album. The second CD includes club mixes by Junior Vasquez with further Bizarre Inc. remixes to follow. Album: Bedtime Stories (October 24).

Line-up: Heavy D (rap), DJ Eddie F. G-Wiz (k). Notes: Playing on the 'night' theme, the single includes snippets from George Benson's Give Me The Night and Ladies Night by Kool & The Gang. The group's first chart single in more than three years is taken from their fifth album. The group, who have sold more than four million albums, have guested on a host of recordings, notably with Michael and Janet Jackson, Hammer

Young Girl has already been a minor hit this year for Joe Longthorne - peaking at No.61 in April. Day, a 26-year-old from Colchester, is starring in Joseph And The Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat. An acoustic version of the show's Any Dream Will Do is included on all formats of the single. Day has also been invited by Pete Townsend to sing a Tommy medley for an upcoming Who tribute album. Album: tba (1995).

45 **SUZI CARR: All Over Me (Cowboy) US debut. Notes:** Carr is the former lead vocalist of Will To Power who scored an international hit with Baby I Love Your Way/Freebird in 1989. All Over Me, which has topped the RM Club Chart, was picked up by Cowboy from the New York based Radikal label. Album: tba (1995).

50 **THE CULT: Coming Down (Beggars Banquet) UK 15th hit. First hit: Resurrection Joe (74, 1984).** Biggest hit: Lil' Devil (11, 1987). Last hit: Sanctuary MCMXC III (15, 1993).
