

## CHART COMMENTARY



For the second week in a row, Cher's Believe shows great tenacity and defeats a challenger to its throne by the margin of 7,000 sales. Last week it was Boyzone who were unable to beat her, this week it's Jay-Z, whose Hard Knock Life has to be content with runners-up spot despite selling more than 107,000 copies. Believe has been number one for seven weeks so far, selling more than 1.1m copies. The last single to spend seven weeks at number one was the Spice Girls' debut hit Wannabe, which did so in 1996.

The last American to spend seven weeks on top was Cher's former duet partner, Meat Loaf – they did Dead Ringer For Love together – who did so with I'd Do Anything For Love (But I Won't Do That) before being dethroned by Mr Blobby exactly five years ago. Believe is only the sixth single by a female soloist ever to sell a million copies in the UK, the others being Jennifer Rush's The Power Of Love (1985), Whitney Houston's I Will Always Love You (1992), Whigfield's Saturday Night (1994)

It's exactly a year ago that the Robbie Williams revival started in earnest with the release of Angels. This week he registers his fourth consecutive top five hit, though he must be a little disappointed with the number four debut of No Regrets, considering the number one success of his most recent single Millennium. Meanwhile, Robbie's I've Been Expecting You album dips a notch to number three

but more than 90,000 last week to bring its six week tally to half a million. It has another four weeks to become his second million-selling album of 1998, with sales of Life Thru A Lens this year at 1.1m. Though that has been overtaken by the Corrs, Talk On Corners, combined sales of Robbie's two albums this year now exceed 1.6m, making him the year's number one album artist.

although Diane wrote no songs for Cher's current album – she has had an even more successful time of it in the charts this year than Cher, with an uninterrupted presence in the Top 40 for her songs stretching back to March 7, when How Do I Live made its debut in a version by LeAnn Rimes. Warren has two songs on the Top 40 this week, with Aerosmith's I Don't Want To Miss A Thing easing down to number 20 on its 14th appearance (sales to date: 500,000), while Have You Ever? debuts at number 13 for Brandy. Rimes is back in the chart too, debuting at number 23 with Blue, a song written by Bill Mack over 30 years ago. The fact that How Do I Live is a bonus track on the record has certainly not harmed it one bit.

Having Sold more than 500,000 copies of their selftitled album since I Want You reached number 11, 18 months ago, Savage Garden re-release it – though it seems unlikely to better its original chart peak, having debuted at number 12 this week.




Album sales soared to a 1998 high last week for the second week in a row, a 17.5% increase in week-on-week sales taking them to 4,535,000, with artist albums accounting for nearly 71% of the total. The boom is helping most albums, regardless of whether they are climbing or falling, and the only albums in the Top 20 to see sales decline last week were **U2's The Best Of 1980-1990** and **Alanis Morissette's Supposed Former Infatuation Junkie**. The biggest gainers were **Boyzone's Where We Belong** (up 10-5 with a 61% increase) and **The Best Of M People**, which soared 6-2 with a 25% improvement. The **M People** album sold 104,000 copies, and is the third biggest selling artist compilation of the year, behind the **George Michael** and **James** collections, with sales of 330,000 in five weeks.

With most of the year's big sellers already out, the only new entries to the Top 75 are two best of collections with identical titles -- Irish duo **Foster & Allen's Greatest Hits**

debuting at number 56, while the late **2Pac** enters at number 73 with his album of the same name. The Irish folk act made their UK

**Ladies & Gentlemen - The Best Of George Michael** had its best week at retail last week, and becomes the first album by George to spend four weeks at number one. Each of Michael's three previous solo albums topped the chart, but **Faith and Listen Without Prejudice Volume One** each spent just one week on top, while **Older** reigned for three weeks. **Ladies & Gentlemen** sold 145,000 on its first week, 111,000 on its

second, 135,000 on its third, and 150,000 last week. With sales generally on a steep upwards trajectory towards Christmas and his **Saturday Parkinson** special providing an additional boost, **Ladies & Gentlemen** will likely have another major increase in sales next week and is certain to sell a million before the year is through. Its current tally of 541,000 sales puts it in 12th place for the year.

number 18 in the chart. Their only subsequent Top 40 appearance came with **Maggie** in 1983. It became the title track of their debut chart album later that year, since when they have had a staggering 21 hit albums, appearing in the chart each and every year. In the whole of chart history, **Van Morrison** is the only Irish act with more hit albums, and in last 15 years, no one -- Irish, British or from anywhere else -- has had more chart albums -- yet they have yet to reach the Top 10, their personal peak coming in 1986, when they reached number 11 with **Reminiscing**.

The biggest-selling live album of the year, **The Bee Gees' One Night Only** album slips a notch to number six this week but enjoys its best week yet, with a further 80,000 sales taking its total to 300,000. That's an exceptional total for a live album but way short of the biggest selling live album of the Nineties, **Phil Collins' Serious Hits... Live!**, which more than a million copies.


## COMPILATIONS

For the second week in a row, **Now That's What I Call Music! 41** outsold all other albums last week, its tally of 208,500 being nearly 60,000 more than the number one artist album, **Ladies & Gentlemen - The Best Of George Michael**. In a year of some problems for the compilation market, it is proving the **Now!** brand is as strong as ever, and is even outpacing **Now! 38**, which topped the chart last Christmas. After two weeks on release, **Now! 38** had sold 318,000 copies, while **Now! 41** has done considerably better, selling 399,000. It seems certain to stay at the top of the compilation chart for the rest of the year, having outsold its nearest competitor **Cher - The South Park Album** by a margin of just exactly five to one last week. The fastest moving album in the chart is

**The Best Christmas Album In The World...Ever!**, the Virgin/EMI compilation which soars 21-4. Having sold over 500,000 copies in the last two years, it has done very well to muscle its way to the top again this year, as there are three other similarly themed albums currently competing with it for TV advertising exposure and consumer preference -- PolyGram's **Ultimate Christmas Collection**, which jumps 30-12, Global TV's **The Christmas Album** (new at number 17) and Warner's **Simply The Best Christmas**, which climbs 37-33. The EMI/Virgin and PolyGram albums concentrate on the more 'poppy' Christmas fare, dating from the Seventies seasonal hits of Slade, Mud and Gary Glitter through **Band Aid to East 17** and **Cliff Richard**, while **The Christmas Album** is a little more eclectic.


