**1. Elvis Presley**  
The first single ever to enter the chart at number one (in January 1958) Jailhouse Rock is also the latest, 67th chart number one returns to the summit this week as the 999th number one. With first week sales of 21,262 – including an incredible 6,065 10-inch sales – it was Presley's second number one, and it is now his 19th number one, topping the chart a day after what would have been his 70th birthday. It extends his span of number one hits to a phenomenal, unmatched 47-years.



**3. Iron Maiden**  
To celebrate those monstrous heavy metal legends' 25th anniversary as a chart force, Iron Maiden's number 18 hit The Number of the Beast – the title track of their chart-topping 1982 album – was reissued on Monday and, though slightly overshadowed by the return of Jailhouse Rock and Elvis Presley, it acquires itself superbly, debuting at number three with first week sales of 14,279. It is the group's 15th Top 10 hit, and their highest charting single since Be Quick Or Be Dead which reached number two in 1992.

**2. The Killers**  
American groups fill the top four places on the album chart this week, shutting out homegrown talent. Amongst them is The Killers' Hot Fuss - which debuted at number six last June - and reached a new peak of five last week. It now progresses to number two, thanks to steadily increasing airplay support for their introductory single Somebody Told Me, which is about to be re-released. The Killers' album sold 32,234 copies last week, to take its total sales to date to 437,583 sales and also powers to all time new peak in America, where it moves an incredible 51-24 and increases its 29 week sales tally to 812,827.



**5. Franz Ferdinand**  
Attractively priced at less than £10 in most retail outlets at present, and high on most critics' choice of the best albums of last year, Franz Ferdinand's self-titled debut album has turned around dramatically since dropping from the top 40 for the first time last month. Moving 43-41-35-10-5, the album is now just two places off the number three peak position in which it made its debut last February, and has thus far sold 301,274 copies.

 Kasabian's self-titled debut album generates its fourth and biggest Top 20 hit this week, as Curt Off debuts at number eight. The band's previous singles - Club Foot, LSF and Processed Beats - peaked at 19, 10 and 17 respectively. This, and a renewed TV advertising campaign for the album, help it to improve its chart placing for the fifth week in a row. The album has moved 81-72-63-53-35-17 in that time, and is currently enjoying its highest placing for 16 weeks. The album, which debuted and peaked at number four last September, has so far sold 242,064 copies.



**66. Ashanti**  
 With introductory single Only U leaping 71-36 on the radio airplay chart, Ashanti's Concrete Rose album has finally made the Top 75. The album has moved 92-89-95-66 since its December release, selling 28,569 copies. Its poor showing so far contrasts with the R&B diva's last album Chapter II, which opened at number five in June 2003, and has thus far sold more than 136,000 copies. In America - where Only U is number 14 on the Hot 100 - Concrete Rose reached number seven, and has sold 529,801 copies since its release last month.
