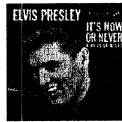

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**1. Elvis Presley**  
Clara's interruption last week stopped Elvis Presley from completing a unique hat-trick of number ones with different singles on consecutive weeks, but he's back on top again this week, this time with *It's Now Or Never*, originally a number one hit for him in 1960, when Aaron Schroeder and Wally Gold set new lyrics to the 1901 Italian composition *O Sole Mio*. *It's Now Or Never* also hits in the highest first-week sales in the current phase of re-release, selling 21,387 copies last week to beat the previous best of 21,262 set by *Jahthouse Rock* four weeks ago.



**2. Ashanti**  
After securing her first number one to date in partnership with R Kelly and Ja Rule last November, Ashanti registers the second biggest hit of her career, debuting at number two this week with only U. Both tracks are included on her current album *Concrete Rose*, which had climbed for three weeks but slips back a little this week, despite selling more copies than in any previous week. The album was released just before Christmas, and has since earned 97,879,956-66 45 25 32.

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**6. The Lovefreekz Shine**  
 It seems 2005 could herald a return to prominence for dance music, with each of the four chart weeks this year delivering at least one dance tune into the Top 10 and, in total, six have already made their presence felt. The latest is The Lovefreekz's Shine. Sampling the Electric Light Orchestra's 1979 number six hit Shine A Little Love, it matches that placing this week - and could possibly have done even better had it not been around on white label since last June, when it reached number 136 on the chart.



**10. Hanson White Busted**  
 White Busted became a memory. Freefaller are the latest instrument-playing boy band to break through. The longevity of such groups is usually limited, so it is quite a surprise to see that Freefaller's number eight debut is almost matched by the fraternal trio of Hanson, who break a five-year thought to debut at number 10 with Penny & Me. Penny & Me sold 7771 units last week. Meanwhile, Hanson's massive hit Mmmmbop, from 1997, has sold 715,369 copies to date.
