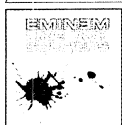

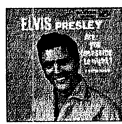

**1. Eminem** registers back-to-back number one singles for the second time in his career, as Like Toy Soldiers - the second single from his current album Encore - over turns a mid-week deficit to pip Elvis Presley to the post. Like Toy Soldiers sold 29,496 copies last week - less than half the 63,312 tally which won Encore's introductory single Just Lose It three weeks ago. The rapper now has 13 straight Top 10 hits and six number ones to his credit. Encore has sold 875,130 copies since its release three months ago.



**2. Elvis Presley** Despite registering the highest weekly sale yet for an Elvis Presley reissue - exactly 28,500 - Are You Lonesome Tonight? fails to deliver Elvis his fourth number one in five weeks, having its initial 14,318 lead over Eminem turn into a deficit of 996 by the end of the week. Are You Lonesome Tonight? topped the sale of previous Presley reissues because BMG has scraped its decision to make limited editions. With new stock available, One Night U/I Got Stung and Jailhouse Rock rebound 40-26 and 57-27, while A Fool Such As I falls 20-22 and It's Now Or Never slides 1-14.

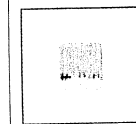

**3. Brian McFadden & Delta Goodrem**  
 The third single from Brian McFadden's debut solo album *Irish Son*, and the second from Delta Goodrem's *Mistaken Identity*, the lovers' duet *Almost Here* debuts at number three this week, beating the peak of their respective last singles - McFadden's *Irish Son* reached number six while Goodrem's *Out Of The Blue* got to number nine. Despite the single's success, both artists' albums dip a little this week. McFadden's *Irish Son* (179,309 sales in 10 weeks) falls 29-30, while Goodrem's *Mistaken Identity* (122,043 sales in 11 weeks) is off 58-67.



**5. Bloc Party**  
 Holly-tipped and critically acclaimed, Bloc Party continue to accelerate to stardom, with the arrival of *So Here We Are/Positive Tension*. The band gained a foothold on the chart last May, reaching number 51 with *Banquet/Staying Fat*, made their Top 40 debut in July with *Little Thoughts/Tulips* reaching number 38 and then hovered at 26 with *Helicopter*. Their debut album *Silent Alarm* is out next Monday (February 14).

**2. Feeder**  
Pushing The Senses earned Feeder some of the best reviews of their career and first single Tumble & Fall got to number five, so it is no surprise to find the album debuting this week at number two with first week sales of 42,511. That's the highest placing of Feeder's career, but the album will have to sell long and well to continue the band's proud boast that each of their albums to date has outsold its predecessors by some distance. 1996's Swim sold 40,000, 1997's Polythene sold 89,000, Yesterday Went Too Soon from 1999 sold 110,000, 2001's Echo Park sold 293,000 and 2002's Comfort In Sound sold 435,000.



**4. Michael Bublé**  
It's Time is the second proper album release by Canada's jazz crooner Michael Bublé. His self-titled 2003 debut album reached number six and has thus far sold nearly 620,000 copies in the UK, so it is no surprise to find follow-up It's Time beating that peak and debuting at number four with first-week sales of 36,517. Featuring covers of the Beatles' Can't Buy Me Love, Stevie Wonder's You And I and Bublé duetting with Nelly Furtado on Quando, Quando, Quando, It's Time debuts at the jazz chart's summit.

**9. Elvis Presley**  
Anthologising 24 of Elvis Presley's more romantic ballads, Elvis is perfectly timed to catch a wave, not only from the current Presley singles reissues campaign but also from its suitability as a Valentine's Day gift. Not surprisingly, the album Love Elvis debuts at number nine, after selling 23,995 copies. It's Presley's 107th hit album - the most by any artist - but the first to add to his total since Christmas Peace, which reached number 41 in both December 2003 and December 2004.



**17. Lemon Jelly**  
Previously heaped with praise by music critics, Lemon Jelly were given a less easy ride with their third album '64-'95, which arrived in stores last week but which never the less gives the sample-happy citrus gelatine mob their highest charting album to date, debuting at 17 with first-week sales of 15,027. Their introductory album Lemon Jelly Ky - a compilation of their first three EPs - has sold 84,472 since its 2000 release, although it peaked at number 127. Their first proper album Lost Horizons, debuted and peaked at number 20 in 2002 and has sold 127,219 copies.
