1. U2
U2 land back-to-back number one singles for the first time in their career, debuting in pole position with *Sometimes You Can't Make It On Your Own* - the second single from their new album *The Unforgettable Fire*. The band's previous number one was *The Fly* in 1987. *Sometimes You Can't Make It On Your Own* is U2's third straight number one and seventh in all. First week sales of 30,359 are substantially fewer than *Vertigo*'s opening 51,917 tally, while the album has sold 947,423 copies. U2's North American single *All Because Of You* also charts here this week, debuting at number 51 on import sales.



2. Elvis Presley
Losing a substantial lead for the second week in a row, the late Elvis Presley again has to settle for runners-up spot this time with *Wooden Heart*, whose first week sales of 28,377 are below the 28,500 copies *Are You Lonesome Tonight* sold a week ago but higher than the other reissues. The latest in his 70th birthday celebration number one re-releases, *Wooden Heart* brings to six the number of Presley singles in the Top 40 - one short of the chart record Presley himself set in 1957.

4. Destiny's Child Racking up their 10th Top 10 hit, Destiny's Child debut at four with Soldier, the second single from their Destiny Fulfilled album. Introductory single Lose My Breath spent four weeks at two last November and has turned first week sales of 61,287 into 226,287 - more than most number ones these days. Soldier's first week tally was 17,314. Its release hasn't stopped the slow downward drift of Destiny Fulfilled. The album debuted and peaked at number five and slips 40-43 this week. It has sold 469,168 copies.



6. Doves The Doves' third album proper Some Cities - a tally that excludes the Last Sides compilation - arrives next week with many glowing reviews but this week it is the turn of introductory single Black And White Town to hog the limelight. Debuting at six, it beats the peak position of all the group's singles to date, save for There Goes The Fear, the first single from second album The Last Broadcast, which opened at three and set up their number one debut.

4. Franz Ferdinand
Scoping Brits for best British group and best British rock act, while performing a well received Take Me Out helped Franz Ferdinand's self-titled debut album to celebrate its first birthday by storming back into the Top 10. The album, released on 9 February 2004, jumps 13-4, to earn - surprisingly - its highest placing since its number three debut a year ago and only its 11th week in the Top 10. It sold 46,476 copies last week, a week-on-week jump of 159.7% - to take its cumulative sales to 925,104.



9. Phil Collins
TV advertising very successfully pitched Phil Collins' Love Songs: A Compilation... Old & New to the Valentine's Day market last week. The album, which was flattening in 61st place on the chart a fortnight ago, jumped to 42 last week and now catapults to nine, beating the number 10 debut/speak it achieved last October. The album sold 24,106 copies last week - a 375% improvement week-on-week - to take its cumulative sales to 472,381. The campaign also had a spin-off effect on Collins' triple disc Platinum Collection, which jumps 113-70 with sales up 96.8% week-on-week.

29. Michael McDonald
Michael McDonald's tribute album Motown reached 29 in 2003, selling nearly 35,000 copies. It was even more successful in America, where it reached number 14 and sold more than 500,000 copies, prompting McDonald to revisit the Motown songbook for Motown Two, which duly reached number nine in the States last November and has thus far sold more than 360,000 copies.
