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**1. Jennifer Lopez**  
Registering her 13th hit in all, Jennifer Lopez has the second number one single of her career with Get Right, which is the eighth different number one of 2005 in as many weeks, and the one with the largest weekly sales tally, shifting 192,228 copies last week. Lopez's only previous chart-topper, Love Don't Cost A Thing, debuted at number one in January 2001, with first-week sales of 67,879. Get Right uses a fabulous song of the same name, and, according to Usher, it is the same tune as Ride, a track he put out on 12-inch last year, which was produced by Rich Harrison, who also co-produced the Lopez single.



**2. Elvis Presley**  
For the third time in as many weeks an Elvis Presley reissue debuts at number two. Surrender - a four-week chart-topper in 1961 - is this week's runner-up and, like its predecessors, it topped the chart on the first midweek sales flashes but was unable to hold on. In fact, it ended up well beaten, with a final tally of 24,429 proving to be less than half the sales which earn Lopez the number one slot this week. Next week's Elvis reissue is (Marie's The Name) His Latest Flame, also a chart-topper in 1961.

**3. LL Cool J**  
 A number 26 hit in the US Hot 100 last year, LL Cool J's Hush makes a much bigger splash in the UK, where it debuts at number three this week to become the third biggest hit of his career. Hush extends his run of Top 40 hits to 17 in a little more than 17 years. It is a very belated second single from last August's album The Definition, from which previous single Headsprung was a number 25 UK hit. The album, which peaked at 66 and has sold fewer than 20,000 copies, has moved 134-150-125 in the past fortnight.



**11. Enbrace**  
 Let go by Hit/Winem after their 2001 album If You've Never Been Sold just 59,254 copies, Enbrace have enjoyed a big renaissance in the past few months. They register their third straight Top 20 hit this week, debuting at number 11 with Looking As You Are, having reached seven with Gravity last September, and then 11 with November following Ashes. Sales of the album Out Of Nothing - home to all three singles - have exceeded all their previous albums, with a 23-week tally of 440,643.

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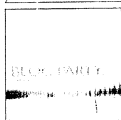

**3. Bloc Party**  
Only of only two new arrivals with enough clout to secure a Top 50 debut this week, Bloc Party's first album *Silent Alarm* arrives in some style, entering the chart at number three with first-week sales of 61,737. Debuting two weeks after their breakthrough single *So Here We Are/Positive*, the album has won rave reviews from the music and press, with the *Sunday Times* proclaiming the band as the "next Franz Ferdinand". Their profile has also been helped by a slot on the NME Awards Tour, and they are currently on their own headline UK tour.



**10. U2**  
Hot on the heels of their Brits and a week after the album's second single *Sometimes You Can't Make It On Your Own* topped the chart, U2's latest set *How to Dismantle an Atomic Bomb* jumps 14-10 to return to the Top 10 after an absence of seven weeks. It has sold extremely well so far, attracting 972,248 sales in just 13 weeks. By comparison, the band's last album of new material - 2000's *All That You Can't Leave Behind* - sold a more modest 542,499 copies in its first 13 weeks in the shops.

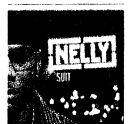

**13. Nelly** Renewed TV advertising and massive radio support for upcoming single Over & Over - on which he is paired with Tim McGraw - have spurred Nelly's Soul album to major gains in the past fortnight. The album, which peaked at number eight last

September, has climbed 57-32-13, and has also seen its sales (though not always its position) increase in each of the past six weeks. It has now sold 159,538 copies, its companion album Street - which was released simultaneously with Soul and reached number 11 - has seen spin-off benefits, even though it doesn't feature Over & Over, and has moved 132-95-80 in the past fortnight. Its sales to date are 106,153.



**26. The Streets** When Able Skiner won two Brit awards this month, his second album A Grand Don't Come For Free was at number 77 in the chart - the lowest position of its 29-week career. It leapt to 50 last week, and makes another massive move this week, jumping to 26 - though its latest leap is also helped by the fact that it was repackaged with a DVD last week. The album is in its highest position for 20 weeks, and the 13,875 copies it sold last week take its total sales to 921,226.
