**2. ELVIS PRESLEY**  
With only *Crying In The Chapel, The Wonder Of You* and *Way Down to Go in the Elvis Presley 70th birthday reissue campaign*, he registers a top five debut for the 14th week in a row, thanks to the *Elvis In Disguise*, which enters at two with first week sales of 26,379. When the record topped the chart 42 years ago, it was during a rich vein of chart success by British acts - out of 23 number ones from the start of 1963 to October 1964, 26 were by homegrown acts, one by an Irish act (the Bachelors) based in the UK, and the other was *Devil In Disguise*.



**4. MARIAH CAREY**  
Clocking up her 31st Top 40 hit in a career spanning nearly 15 years, Mariah Carey returns to the Top 10 with *It's Like That*, the introductory single from her 10th studio album, *The Emancipation Of Mimi*, which is itself released next Monday (11th). It's *Life That* debuts at four on sales of 21,809, and is Carey's first hit since she teamed with Busta Rhymes for the number three hit *I Know What You Want* in June 2003. *Mimi*, by the by, is Mariah's alter-ego.

**6. KYLIE MINOGUE**  
 Kylie Minogue's last single, I Believe In You, was denied the opportunity of becoming her eighth number one by Band Aid's Do They Know It's Christmas four months ago. Follow-up Giving You Up cannot get near the current charity favourite, and has to settle for a six debut this week. It does, however, provide the perennially popular Aussie with her 39th Top 40 and 29th Top 10 hit. The track first appeared on Minogue's Ultimate Kylie album, which passed its 700,000th UK sale on Saturday (2nd).



**10. RACHEL STEVENS**  
 Negotiate With Love is the introductory single from Rachel Stevens' yet-to-be named second album but cannot match the top three success of Sweet Dreams My LA Ex, Some Girls and More More More, and debuts at 10. The only dud from her debut album was title track Funky Dory which peaked at 26. The Funky Dory album has sold 221,623 copies - more than the last S Club album, Seeing Double, at 183,091.

**5. New Order**  
With glowing reviews and first week sales of 25,608, New Order's Waiting For The Sirens' Call - their first album for nearly four years - is the week's top debut, at five. It does not quite match their last album, Get Ready, which opened with sales of 32,669 in 2001, but it lifts the group's tally of Top 10 albums to 10. The new album's introductory single Krafty reached eight last month, faring as well in chart terms as any New Order single since 1993, though critics seem to prefer the title track and Tun. **15. Will Smith**  
Will Smith has had nine Top 10 singles from 10 solo releases but his albums do not do nearly so well, with 1997's Big Willie Style barely scraping into the top tier, at number nine, while 1999's Millennium peaked at number 10, and 2002's Born to Reign disappointed at number 24. New album Lost And Found debuts at number 15. Its first week sales - 15,370 - surpass Lost And Found's 7,219 opening and beat Big Willie Style's 5,342 start (at number 69) but trail the inflated 30,173 November opening score of Millennium.

Generally more of a shop window for R&B and jazz artists, veteran chat show host Michael Parkinson's new ITV series entertained R&B newcomer John Legend last week and, as its title suggests, the album could do nothing but Get Lifted. In 11 previous weeks, the album sold 35,487 copies, and climbed no higher than number 56, but Parky's patronage propels the album 110-32 in this week's chart, with week-on-week sales up 188% to 8,018, taking Get Lifted's total to 43,505. Parkinson's latest singing guest, Anastacia, should see a boost next week.
