What we affectionately refer to as the "Westlife curse" (sometimes also the "Oasis curse") is the fun way in that despite their record-buggering string of Number One hits, Westlife singles tend to be rather here today gone tomorrow releases, typically remaining at the top for no more than a week before charging spectacularly to the lower reaches. Thus it is actually a matter worthy of some comment when one of their tracks actually holds on to a place at the top. Such is the honour achieved by 'You Raise Me Up' this week which fails to succumb to any challenges from lower down and spends a second week at the summit of the singles chart. That makes it "only" the fourth Westlife single to manage more than a week at the top.
