Finally for this week a not altogether unwelcome re-release at Number 28 for My Chemical Romance. 'I'm Not Okay (I Promise)' first hit Number 19 back in March since when the group have had two further Top 30 hits in the shape of 'Helena' and 'The Ghost Of You'. The plan I suspect was to re-release their strongest track in the hope of picking up slightly more mainstream attention than they have garnered at the moment. It wasn't a bad idea - even if it doesn't seem to have paid off quite as they had
